ISRO Launches PSLV C-45 Carrying EMISAT And 28 Nano Satellites

i. The Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO) has launched a Defence Intelligence Satellite, EMISAT in its 47th Polar Satellite Launch Vehicle (PSLV) mission, along with 28 other customer satellites, onboard the advanced PSLV-C45 Rocket.



- ii. The PSLV C45 was launched from ISRO's Satish Dhawan Space Centre in Sriharikota. It is the first time ISRO is launching satellites in three different orbits. Along with that, the PSLV-C45 launch vehicle is also the first PSLV rocket to use four strap-on motors.

Dhanbad Tops 4G Availability Chart In India

i. A report by OpenSignal, which is named as 'OpenSignal's Hottest city for 4G Availability' reveals the 4G Availability in India's 50 largest cities.

ii. Out of the 50 cities, **Dhanbad**, which is also known as the coal capital of India has the highest 4G availability of 95.3%, followed by **Ranchi** which has 95% of 4G Availability.

iii. Notably, both Ranchi and Dhanbad are two cities in **Jharkhand** and they are the only two cities to have over 95% of 4G coverage.



Telangana Tops In eLearning Training For Field Staff

i. For the second year in succession, Telangana ranks number 1 in the e-Learning training program of the Department of Personnel and Training (DoPT), Government India.

ii. During the financial year 2018-19, Dr. MCR HRD Institute enrolled over 20,000 field staff in different districts of the State to impart training on 12 soft skills modules and 3 domain-specific modules.



Kandhamal Haldi Gets Geographical Indications Tag

i. 'Kandhamal Haldi', a variety of turmeric indigenous to southern Odisha, has earned the Geographical indication (GI) tag from Intellectual Property India, an organization functioning under the auspices of the Union ministry of commerce & industry.

ii. The recognition coincided with the state's Foundation Day (Utkal Divas). Kandhamal in Odisha's southern hinterland is famed for its turmeric.

Government Sets Up Tribunal To Review Ban Imposed On Jamaat-e-Islami, JKLF

i. The Centre has set up a tribunal, headed by **Justice Chander Shekhar** of the Delhi High Court, to adjudicate if there exists sufficient cause to ban the **Jamaat-e-Islami Jammu and Kashmir (Jel)** and the Jammu and Kashmir Liberation Front-Yasin Malik (**JKLF-Y**) faction.

ii. The decision has been taken by the **Home Ministry** exercising the powers conferred under the **Unlawful Activities** (**Prevention**) **Act.**



Lakshmi Vilas Bank To Merge With Indiabulls Housing Finance

i. The board of Lakshmi Vilas Bank (LVB) approved the merger of the private sector lender with Indiabulls Housing Finance (IBH) through a share swap deal.

ii. The merger will also enable **Tamil Nadu-based LVB** to obtain a larger geographical presence. The merged entity will have a net worth Rs19,472 crore and a loan book Rs1,23,393 crore for the nine months of FY19.

BSNL Gets Licence For WiFi On Flights

i. State-owned telecom service provider Bharatiya Sanchar Nigam Limited (BSNL) has received a licence from the Department of Telecommunications to provide Internet and mobile services on flights.

ii. BSNL and its satellite partner, Inmarsat, will be able to offer in-flight connectivity to airlines.

IIT-Madras Tops HRD's National Ranking of Institutes

i. President Ram Nath Kovind has released the national ranking of higher institutes by the Ministry of Human Resources Development (HRD) in New Delhi.



- ii. Indian Institute of Technology Madras topped the rankings while the Indian Institute of Science, Bangalore bagged the second rank followed by IIT Delhi.
- iii. Delhi University's Miranda House was ranked the best among colleges across the country, while the varsity's St Stephen's College was ranked fourth.

India Highest Recipient of Remittances At \$79 billion in 2018: World Bank

i. As per the World Bank Report, India retained its position as the world's top recipient of remittances with its diaspora sending a whopping USD 79 billion back home in 2018. India was followed by China (USD 67 billion).

ii. The Report was titled as 'World Bank's Migration and Development Brief'. Over the last three years, India has registered a significant flow of remittances from USD 62.7 billion in 2016 to USD 65.3 billion 2017.



WhatsApp Launches Tip Line To Curb Fake News

i. WhatsApp launched an India-focused fact-checking feature to combat fake news and rumours starting with the run-up to the Lok Sabha elections.

ii. Developed in collaboration with India-based media skilling startup **PROTO**, the tip line feature will help create a **database** of rumours to study misinformation during elections as part of a research project commissioned and assisted by **WhatsApp**.

HDFC AMC Ranks 1st In Terms Of Assets: AMFI Report

i. India's asset management companies (AMCs) own assets under management (AUM) worth Rs24.46 trillion, according to data released by the Association of Mutual Funds in India (Amfi).

ii. HDFC Asset Management Co. Ltd has claimed the top spot with an average AUM of Rs3.42 trillion, overtaking ICICI Prudential Asset Management Co. Ltd with an average AUM of at Rs3.20 trillion.



Reliance Mutual Fund Launches Voice-Based Financial Transactions

i. Reliance Nippon Life Asset Management (RNAM) has joined hands with Google to enable the customers of Reliance Mutual Fund to carry out voice-based financial transactions.

ii. With this, RNAM becomes the first company in India, to provide a conversational interface that would help customers regarding funds transactions.

Kotak Mahindra Bank Becomes First Lender To Charge For UPI Use

i. Kotak Mahindra Bank (Kotak) stated that it will charge customers for UPI transactions starting 1st of May 2019. For each Kotak Bank account, the first 30 UPI fund transfers will be free, after which a charge will be levied on all fund transfers from the bank account.

ii. This will be applicable across all platforms, including Paytm, PhonePe, Google Pay or Truecaller Pay among others. The bank will charge **Rs 2.50** per transaction for an amount value below or equal to **Rs 1,000**, and **Rs 5 per** transaction will be levied for a payment value above Rs 1,000.

i. The

Indian Publishing company, **Garuda Prakashan** Private Limited, launched its book '**Saffron Swords-** Centuries of Indic Resistance to Invaders'.

Phayeng Village Becomes India's 1st Carbon-Positive Settlement

i. Phayeng Village in Imphal West district of Manipur has become India's first carbon-positive settlement.

ii. A village is given carbon-positive tag if it sequesters more carbon than it emits, slowing accumulation of greenhouse gases (GHGs) and mitigating effects of climate change. Phayeng Village is scheduled caste village of the Chakpa community.



Guwahati Railway Station 1st To Get ISO Certification In India

i. The Guwahati Railway Station has become the first ever railway station in the Indian Railways to get an ISO certification from the National Green Tribunal (NGT) for "providing passenger amenities in a clean and green environment."

ii. Many types of ISO certification exist and the one received by Guwahati Railway Station is **ISO-14001**, which is for Environment Management System as per international norms which were upgraded in 2015. Thus, the station's certificate reads **ISO 14001**: 2015.

Astronomers Capture First-ever Image of A Black Hole

i. Astronomers have taken the first-ever image of a black hole, which is located in a distant galaxy known as 'Messier 87' (M87).

ii. The image which has been captured by a network of eight telescopes across the world shows an intensely bright 'ring of fire' surrounding a perfectly circular dark hole.

iii. The 'Event Horizon Telescope' captured the image from the galaxy that is 50 million lightyears awav.



Airtel, FICCI Ladies Organisation Launch Women's Safety App

i. Bharti Airtel and the FICCI Ladies Organisation (FLO, the women business wing of apex trade body FICCI) launched a carrier agnostic safety app named 'My Circle' which has been designed to empower women in the event of any distress or panic situation.

ii. My Circle app enables women to send SOS alerts to any five of their family or friends in 13 languages including English, Hindi, Tamil, Telugu, Malayalam, Kannada, Marathi, Punjabi, Bangla, Urdu, Assamese, Oriva, and Guiarati.

India's Population Grew At 1.2 % Average Annual Rate Between 2010 And 2019: UN Report

i. India's population grew at an average annual rate of 1.2% between 2010 and 2019 to 1.36 billion, more than double the annual growth rate of China, according to a report by the United Nations Population Fund (UNPFA).

ii. India's population in 2019 stood at 1.36 billion, growing from 942.2 million in 1994. In comparison, China's population stood at 1.42 billion in 2019, growing from 1.23 billion in 1994.

i. HDFC Bank has been identified as number 1 bank by customers in India, as per Forbes World's Best Bank survey. In the first edition of this survey, Forbes partnered with market research firm Statista to measure the best banks in 23 countries. ii. HDFC Bank emerged as India's No 1 bank. ICICI Bank was at number 2 and SBI was surprisingly ranked 11th in the list.

DoT Approves Merger of Tata Tele Unit & Airtel With Riders

i. The Department of Telecommunications (DoT) has approved the merger of Tata Teleservices with Bharti Airtel Ltd., subject to the condition that it furnishes a Rs 7200 crore bank guarantee.

ii. Telecom Minister Manoj Sinha gave his conditional nod for the merger. The guarantees are mostly related to one-time spectrum charges (OTSC) and some deferred airwave charges, according to people aware of the development.

India's First Foreign Interactive Bird Park Launched In Mumbai

i. India's first exotic Bird Park 'Essel World Bird Park' was launched by Essel World Leisure Pvt. Ltd, the entertainment arm of the **\$6-billion** Essel Group in **Mumbai**.

ii. The Park is spread over 1.4 acres of land and surrounded by flora and fauna. It is home to over 500 exotic birds from more than 60 species of flying, terrestrial and aquatic birds and has 200 species of special plants and trees for the birds.



Rongali Bihu Festival Celebrated In Assam

i. Assam's most awaited festival - the Rongali Bihu, also known as 'Bohaag Bihu' which marks the beginning of the new Assamese calendar year started.



ii. In Assam, three Bihu festivals are celebrated in a year called as Rongali Bihu or Bohag Bihu, Bhugali (Magh Bihu) and Kangali (Kati Bihu) for marking the distinctive phase in the farming calendar.

i. India ranked 140th out of 180 countries in the World Press Freedom Index 2019, released by Reporters Without Borders. The index is topped by Norway.

ii. Paris-based Reporters Sans Frontieres (RSF), or Reporters Without Borders, is a non-profit organisation that works to document and combat attacks on journalists around the world.

India was ranked 17th position among 100 countries in Startup Ecosystem Ranking for 2019 released by StartupBlink. It was ranked 37th spot last year.

i. The Reserve Bank of India will shortly issue ₹ 20 denomination banknotes in the Mahatma Gandhi (New) Series, bearing the signature of Shri Shaktikanta Das, Governor, Reserve Bank of India.

ii. The new denomination has the motif of Ellora Caves on the reverse, depicting the country's cultural heritage. The base colour of the note is Greenish Yellow. The dimension of the banknote will be 63 mm x 129 mm.



Cyclone 'Fani' Intensifies Over Bay of Bengal

i. Cyclonic storm 'Fani' is likely to hit Coastal Andhra Pradesh by April 30 as it intensified into a severe storm and trigger thunderstorms, gusty winds and moderate rains in coastal districts and some parts of Rayalaseema .

ii. Cyclone Fani currently lays over east **Equatorial Indian Ocean (EIO)** and adjoining the southeast Bay of Bengal.

Tesla Builds Its 'Largest Energy Storage System In Asia'

i. Tesla has developed its 'largest power storage system in Asia' at Osaka train station in Japan to reduce energy demand and provide emergency backup power to trains in Japan.

ii. It was Launched in partnership with Kintetsu, a railway operator in Japan's Osaka. 7 megawatt-hours (MWh) system is its largest energy storage project in Asia and the fourth largest in the greater Asia-Pacific (APAC) region.

ii. It was launched by a Long March-3B carrier rocket from the Xichang Satellite Launch Centre in southwest China's Sichuan Province.




Japan Unveils Name of Its New Imperial Era 'Reiwa'

i. Japan has announced that the name of its new imperial era, set to begin on 1 May, will be 'Reiwa', signifying order and harmony. The country's current era, Heisei, will end in April.
ii. The name 'Reiwa' which consists two Chinese characters, the first meaning 'good' or 'beautiful' as well as 'order' or 'command' and the second meaning 'peace' or 'harmony'.

South Korea Launches World's First National 5G Networks



i. South Korea launches the world's first fully-fledged 5G mobile networks. The system will bring smartphones near-instantaneous connectivity 20 times faster than the existing 4G allowing users to download entire movies in less than a second.
ii. It is crucial for the future development of devices ranging from self-driving vehicles that send data traffic to one another in real time, industrial robots, drones and other elements of the Internet of Things.

ii. The 23-story-tall Heavy, which previously launched Musk's cherry red Tesla roadster to space in a 2018 debut test flight, blasted off from Florida's Kennedy Space Center carrying its first customer payload.



Google Launches New Cloud Platform Anthos

i. Google launched **Anthos**, a new open platform from **Google Cloud**, that lets users run applications from anywhere.

ii. Anthos allows users to run applications, unmodified, on existing on-premise hardware or on the public cloud and is based on the Cloud Services Platform that Google announced in 2018.


Hong Kong's Stock Market Overtakes Japan To Be World's 3rd Largest

i. Hong Kong's equity market has overtaken Japan to be the world's third largest in value, behind only the U.S. and mainland China.

ii. Hong Kong's market cap was \$5.78 trillion, compared with \$5.76 trillion for Japan, according to data compiled by Bloomberg based on where primary securities are listed.

Nepal and Sri Lanka Launches Its First Satellite From USA

Saudi Arabia To Host G20 Summit In 2020







Bajrang Punia To Become 1st Indian Wrestler To Fight At Madison Square Garden

i. Bajrang Punia is set to become the first wrestler from India to fight at the iconic Madison Square Garden in New York. The 25-year-old has recently won the gold medal in the 65-kg category at the ongoing Asian Wrestling Championships.

ii. He is the first Indian wrestler to be invited by the American governing body. Punia will take part in the "Grapple at the Garden - Beat the Streets" fight night.



Asian Wrestling Championship 2019 Concludes: India Finishes With 16 Medals, Iran Tops

i. India wrapped up their campaign at the Asian Wrestling Championships on a resounding note with 16 medals (1 Gold, 3 Silver & 4 Bronze) after Harpreet Singh settled for a silver in 82kg on the final day of competitions.

ii. Only Bajrang Punia won the gold medal after defeating Kazakhstan's Sayatbek Okassov by 12-7 in 65kg men's freestyle. Asian Wrestling Championship 2019 was held at Xi'an, China.

Eminent Dramatist Kartik Chandra Rath Passes Away

i. Kartik Chandra Rath, a veteran dramatist, theatre organiser, and Economics teacher passed away at the age of 70 in Cuttack, Odisha due to the heart attack.

ii. In 1963, he wrote the first play titled 'Ei Desha, Ei Maati'.

ii. Mahendran has directed several memorable films including **Mullum Malarum**, Johnny and Nenjathai Killadhey.



i. Biologist Sydney Brenner who helped decipher the genetic code and jointly won the 2002 Nobel Prize in Physiology or Medicine, passed away at the age of 92.



ii. He had jointly won the Nobel Prize for "discoveries concerning genetic regulation of organ development and programmed cell death".

Renowned Hindi Poet Pradeep Choubey Passes Away

- i. Renowned Hindi poet Pradeep Choubey passed away of a cardiac arrest.
- ii. Choubey (70) was the younger brother of celebrated humorist, satirist, and poet Shail Chaturvedi.

K.M. Mani, Longest-Serving Legislator in Kerala's History, Passes Away

- i. Kerala Congress (M) chairman K. M. Mani, the longest-serving legislator in the State's history, is no more. He was 86 years old.
- **ii.** Fondly called 'Mani Saar', had represented the Pala Assembly constituency for 52 years on the trot since its formation in 1965. Till now, he has won all the 13 elections from the constituency.

Renowned Space Scientist SK Shivakumar Passes Away

- i. Former Director of Indian Space Research Organisation Satellite Centre (ISAC), SK Shivakumar died at the age of 66 in Bengaluru.
- ii. He hailed from Mysuru, Karnataka. He was part of the team which had developed telemetry system for India's first moon mission **Chandrayan I.**

Scotland All-rounder Con de Lange Passes Away

- i. Scotland all-rounder Con de Lange who had been diagnosed with a brain tumour has passed away at the age of 38.
- ii. The South Africa-born de Lange played 21 internationals for Scotland, making his debut in a T20I against Ireland in June 2015.

NASA's 1st Female Astronaut Candidate Jerrie Cobb Passes Away

- i. America's first female astronaut candidate, pilot Jerrie Cobb passed away in Florida at the age of 88 following a brief illness.
- ii. In 1961, Cobb became the first woman to pass astronaut testing. Altogether, 13 women passed the arduous physical testing and became famous as the Mercury 13.



Eminent Bengali Folk Singer Amar Paul Passes Away

- i. Eminent Bengali folk singer Amar Paul passed away following a cardiac arrest. He was 97. Paul lent his voice in a number of films.
- ii. He has penned several books on folk songs of **Bengal** and received accolades from various academies around the world.



Terry Rawlings, British Film Editor Passes Away

- **i.** Terry Rawlings, a British film and sound editor has passed away. He was an Oscar nominee for his work on Best Picture winner "Chariots of Fire,".
- ii He was born in 1933. The 5-time BAFTA nominee also received a career achievement award from the American Cinema Editors society in 2006.



Lorraine Warren, A Paranormal Investigator Passes Away

- i. One of the most well known paranormal investigator, Lorraine Warren passed away at the age of 92. She investigated haunted houses and other manifestation of paranormal activities throughout her life with her late husband Ed. Warren.
- ii. Both wife and husband founded the **New England Society** at Monroe, Connecticut in **1952**to investigate haunting cases. Famous horror movies like **'Amityville Horror'** and **'Conjuring'** were inspired by her work.



S Muthiah, chronicler of Madras, Passes Away

- i. Chennai's famed chronicler, cartographer, and journalist S. Muthiah, 89, passed away due to age-related ailments.
- ii. He was awarded the Most Excellent Order of the British Empire in 2002 for his accomplishments.

Veteran Lady Mountaineer Rama Sengupta Paul Passes Away

i. April 7 of each year marks the celebration of World Health Day.


ii. The theme of World Health Day 2019 is 'Universal health coverage (UHC): Everyone, Everywhere', according to WHO.
