.....[1] emerged as the Best Governed State in the Large States Category, [2] emerged as the Best Governed State in Small States Category, Chandigarh emerged as the Best Governed Union Territory based on Governance in the 5th edition of Public Affairs Index 2020 (PAI 2020) released by Public Affairs Centre (PAC) recently. While Uttar Pradesh (-1.461), Odisha (-1.201) and Bihar (-1.158) finished at the bottom of the ranking of Large States. Manipur (-0.363), Delhi (-0.289) and Uttarakhand (-0.277) finished at the bottom of the ranking of Small States. Dadar and Nagar Haveli (-0.69), Jammu and Kashmir (-0.50) and Andaman & Nicobar (-0.30) were the least performers in the Union Territory Category. The rankings are based on a Composite Index. The performance is analysed in context of sustainable development defined by 3 pillars – Equity, Growth and Sustainability, 5 Themes, 13 Sustainable Development Goals, and 50 Indicators. The report included Delta Analysis in which the results on state performance and ranking measured as the Delta value over the last five years from 2015- 16 to 2019-20 was covered by PAI 2020. It is based on Equity, Growth and Sustainability. In the Large States Category, in terms of Equity, [3] followed by West Bengal, Odisha are the top performers, while Kerala, Punjab and Maharashtra feature at the bottom. In the Small states, Mizoram is the top performer, Goa is placed at the Bottom. Among Large states [3] Assam and Odisha showed the highest improvement, while Kerala, Karnataka, Uttar Pradesh and Tamil Nadu feature at the bottom. Among small states, Mizoram, Meghalaya have the highest growth with Manipur at the bottom. Himachal ranks 2nd, but has least improvement in Delta value. In terms of Sustainability, Odisha and Haryana show the highest improvement. Bihar, Gujarat, Maharashtra and Assam are placed at the bottom among the Large States. Among small states, Goa is the top performer followed by Delhi and Tripura, while Meghalaya and Mizoram feature at the bottom. Female Worker population ratio has a negative relationship with growth, meaning that Gender Disparities are increasing in high performing states. Female labour force participation is a driving force in the case of high and middle performing states but not in the case of low performing states.

India's first solar energy-driven miniature train was virtually inaugurated at the Veli Tourist Village in[1] by state's Chief Minister (CM) . Developed with an outlay of Rs 10 crore, this train is a part of Rs 60 crore projects undertaken to make facilities of the Veli tourist village at par with international standards. Modelled after the vintage steam locomotive, it covers a distance of 2.5 km with three-bogie train and can carry 45 passengers. Apart from this, he also dedicated Rs 5 crore Urban Park and Rs 2.5 crore swimming pool at the Veli tourist village which is located on the outskirts of the capital where the Veli lake meets the Arabian sea. It features a fully- equipped rail system, including a tunnel, traditional style station and a ticket office. The surplus energy generated by the rail system will be routed to the State Electricity Board Limited grid. A tourist facilitation centre, convention centre, and art cafe will also be opened at the tourist village soon. Notably, the state government had allotted around Rs 120 crore for tourism sector in one year alone. In 2019, the Central government approved the setting up four medical device parks in Andhra Pradesh, Telangana, Tamil Nadu and Kerala to provide world-class products at affordable prices for treatment. In this regard, The honourable CM laid the foundation stone for one of the first medical devices parks in the country, " " at Life Science Park. In accordance with the report on "Household Social Consumption: Education in India as part of 75th round of National Sample Survey(NSS) – from July 2017 to June 2018" conducted by National Statistical Office (NSO), Ministry of Statistics and Programme Implementation (MoSPI), [1] again emerged as the most literate state in the country with 96.2% literacy followed by Delhi (88.7%), Uttarakhand (87.6%), Himachal Pradesh (86.6%) and Assam (85.9%).

Bush in 1992.[1] had also served as the 47th Vice President of the United States with President Barack Obama from January 20, 2009-January 20, 2017. 56-year old[2] is of both Indian Tamil and Afro- Jamaican ancestry. She has authored several books – ‘Superheroes Are Everywhere’, Her Memoir ‘The Truths We Hold: An American Journey’ and ‘Smart on Crime: A Career Prosecutor’s Plan to Make Us Safer’, a children’s book and Maya’s Big Idea’ and Nikki Grimes’ The winner of the US Presidential elections is determined through a system called electoral college. All the 50 states plus Washington DC are given a number of electoral college votes, adding up to a total of 538 votes. A candidate needs to win 270 electoral college votes (50% plus one) to win the election. In the US, no person shall be elected to the office of the President more than twice. In 2008, Barack Obama became the first African-American to be elected (and re-elected) as President of the United States [3] was the only President to serve as President for more than 2 terms (1933-45). He served Three full terms; died 2 months and 23 days into the fourth term.

According to the Union Election Commission (UEC) of Myanmar, [1] National League for Democracy (NLD) is likely to win the 2020 Myanmar elections by securing 346 seats out of 664 seats in the Parliament (as on 13th November) which is enough to form the next government. This will be the second term for... [1] as State Counsellor and second victory for her party NLD. This is the Second Free elections in Myanmar, since the country emerged from Military rule in [2]. His swearing-in ceremony was administered by Honourable Governor along with[1] and 14 Ministers from NDA (National Democratic Alliance) took oath as Ministers[1] has been sworn in as the CM of Bihar for Four Consecutive Terms. He is also taking charge as CM of Bihar for the 7th times in two decades. Four-Time BJP (Bharatiya Janata Party) MLA's (Member of Legislative Assembly), Tarkishore Prasad (Constituency – Katihar) and[2](Constituency – Bettiah) were sworn-in as Deputy Chief Ministers [2] is the First Woman Deputy CM of Bihar. The election results for the 2020 Bihar Legislative Assembly Elections were announced on 10th November, 2020. NDA Alliance secured a majority in the elections by winning 125 seats and securing a majority to form Government. The main opposition Alliance 'Mahagathbandhan' secured 110 seats 41-year old [3] became New Zealand's first- ever Indian-origin Minister as Prime Minister.[4] unveiled her new cabinet after her victory in the 2020 General Elections of New Zealand[3] was appointed as Minister for the Community and Voluntary Sector, Minister for Diversity, Inclusion and Ethnic Communities, Minister for Youth. .....[1] won the 13th Edition of the Indian Premier League (IPL) officially known as Dream11 Indian Premier League 2020 that took place from 19th September- November 10, 2020 at the United Arab Emirates (UAE). A total of 8 teams participated in the event [2] became the runner up in the 13th edition of IPL.[3] of Rajasthan Royals won the Player of the Series [1] won their 5th IPL Title by defeating First-Time Finalists [2] by 5 wickets in the Final at Dubai International Cricket Stadium. Title Winners [1] received INR 20 Crore as Prize Money, whereas Finalists [2] received an amount of INR 12.5 Crore. Trent Boult (New Zealand) of[1] was adjudged as the Player of the Match for his spell of 3/30 in Four Overs [1] became the first team in IPL history to win 5 Titles (2013, 2015, 2017, 2019, 2020) in 13 Editions [4] of Kolkata Knight Riders (KKR) was the most expensive player of IPL 2020. He was sold for INR 15 Crores. Piyush Chawla (India) became the most expensive capped Indian player. Chennai Super Kings bought Piyush Chawla for INR 6.75 Crores. Following his 69-ball 132 (Not Out) against Royal Challengers Bangalore, KL Rahul holds the record for Highest score for an Indian in an IPL innings. Anrich Nortje (South Africa) of Delhi Capitals bowled the Fastest Delivery of All seasons of the Indian Premier League during the match against Rajasthan Royals (RR). The delivery clocked 156.2 kmph shattering the 8-year old record of Dale Steyn (South Africa) (154.4 kmph). Virat Kohli (India) of Royal Challengers Bangalore (RCB) with 4314 Runs leapfrogged MS Dhoni (India) of CSK to become the highest run-scorer by a captain in the history of IPL. Kohli also became the First Batsman to score 5500 IPL runs and the First Indian to score 9000 T20 runs [5] became the First Player to play 200 Games in IPL. Rohit Sharma (India) of Mumbai Indians became the Second player to play 200 Games in IPL. It lasted for 53-days and a total of 60 matches. The Cricket Format of the IPL League is Twenty20 format. The tournament was administered by the Board of Control for Cricket in India (BCCI). The venue of the IPL was shifted from India to UAE due to Pandemic. Due to the Pandemic, the entire tournament was played in a Bio-secure environment. This is the Second time that a complete IPL Tournament is being played outside India. The previous time an entire IPL season was conducted outside of India was the 2nd Edition of IPL (Winners – now defunct Deccan Chargers) which was held in South Africa in 2009.

Chief Justice of India (CJI) Sharad Arvind Bobde inaugurated 'Nyay Kaushal' – India's first ever E-resource centre and virtual court for the Maharashtra Transport and Traffic Department at Judicial Officers Training Institute at [1]. Nyay Kaushal will facilitate electronic-filing of cases in Supreme Court, High Court and district courts across the country. The virtual court will deal with all traffic challan cases from every corner of Maharashtra online. Supreme Court Justice BR Gavai, Chief Justice of Bombay High Court, Dipankar Datta, Former Judge of the Bombay High Court and vice- chairman of the E-courts committee, Justice RC Chavan and Bombay High Court judges, Justices AA Sayed, SS Shinde, PB Varale and ZA Haq. were present in the inaugural ceremony. Justice [2], who is the Chairman of Supreme Court's E-court Committee attended the event virtually. The e-resource centre and virtual court will enable speedy justice for litigants. The e-resource Center is expected to reduce inequalities and enable access to the Supreme Court, High Courts and Taluka Courts. Nyay Kaushal will provide the easiest way of filing court matters by using technology, it will save time, travelling long distances and save costs. Utilizing the Virtual Court, litigants can pay fine and dispose of traffic challan cases with the click of a button on a smartphone or a computer. Judges across the country will have to attend the programme online. Justice [2] stated that Delhi was the first to start virtual traffic courts across India. It received 27, 00, 000 challans received by virtual courts and INR 19.8 Crore was collected by Government online. E-court mobile application has recorded 35 Lakh Hits and 47, 65, 000 cases were registered by e-court websites. E-filing facility is available in 17 High Courts, three High Court Benches and Several District Courts. August 13, 2020, A landmark judgment was passed by three-judge Bench of Supreme Court (SC) headed by Justice [3], as per the Hindu Succession (Amendment) Act, 2005, the daughters will have equal inheritance rights as of sons in the properties of fathers, grandfathers and great-grandfathers.

Youtube, Facebook which generates user generated content continue to remain under [3]. This was the first SCO Summit held in Virtual Format and the third meeting that India participated after becoming a full member in [2]. It should be noted that President Emomali Rahmon of[3] will assume the chairmanship of SCO in 2021. India, as a non-permanent member of the United Nations Security Council (UNSC), beginning from 1 January 2021, will focus on the theme of ‘reformed multilateralism’. Indian soldiers participated in about 50 UN peacekeeping missions and India’s Pharma industry supplying essential medicines to more than 150 countries during the pandemic. India is committed
