It was the first bi-coastal ceremony, filmed from Los Angeles and New York City, United States of America (USA) hosted by Amy Poehler from Beverly Hills, Los Angeles and Tina Fey from New York's Rainbow Room. The 78th Golden Globes Awards 2021 was produced by Dick Clark Productions in association with the Hollywood Foreign Press Association (HFPA). The nominees of the 2021 Golden Globe Award were disclosed by Sarah Jessica Parker, six-time Golden Globe winner, and Taraji P. Henson, Golden Globe winner. For the first time the nominations were announced over a virtual platform due to the COVID-19 pandemic restrictions. 2021 Golden Globe Ambassadors were Satchel Lee and Jackson Lee, children of filmmakers and three-time Golden Globe Nominee Spike Lee and his wife Tonya Lewis Lee, philanthropist. Jackson Lee is the first Black male ambassador of Golden Globes.[1] by chinese Female director Chloé Zhao won the Best Pictures Drama and Chloé Zhao won the Best Director Motion Picture. Chloe Zhao became the first Asian woman and only the 2nd woman to win the best director award after Barbra Streisand who won the award for "Yentl." in 1984.[1] became the first film directed by a female to win the award in this category. Barbra Streisand was the first woman to win the Award(Director) in 1984 for Yentl.[2] was posthumously honoured with the Best Actor Golden Globe award for his performance in the film Ma Rainey's Black Bottom.[3] a television series, has the highest nominations for any tele series and it has won in 4 categories (Best Drama Series, Best Television Actress, Best Television Actor, Best Supporting Actress). The 78th Golden Globes 2021 also honoured Jane Fonda with the Cecil B. DeMille Award, and Norman Lear with the Carol Burnett Award.

(United Nation)’s International Women’s Day (IWD) is annually observed across the globe on[1] to recognise the achievements of the women regardless of their nation, ethnic, language, culture, economic or political. The International Women’s Day on[1] 2021 celebrates the efforts of the women and girls across the globe towards shaping an equal future and recovery from the COVID-19 pandemic. The theme of International Women’s Day 2021 is “[2]”. The theme of IWD 2021 is in line with the theme of the 65th Session of the commission on the Status of Women “Women in public life, equal participation in decision making”. The theme of the International Women’s Day Campaign is “#ChoosetoChallenge”. As a part of the peace movement protesting against world war I in 1913, The first International Women’s Day was observed by the Russian Women on the last Sunday of February. The Russian women again protested for “Bread and Peace” on the last Sunday of February 1917(.....[1] on Gregorian calendar). Following which the Czar abdicated and the provisional government granted the right to vote for women. After World War II, the[1] was widely observed as the International women’s in many countries. During the International Women’s Year, 1975, The United Nations started to celebrate Women Day on[1]. In December 1977, The United Nations General Assembly(UNGA) adopted the resolution and invited the members to proclaim any day of the year, in accordance with their history, traditions and customs, as United Nations Day for Women’s Rights and International Peace. On 6th March 2021,[3] , Minister of State (Independent Charge) Ministry of Ports, Shipping and Waterways virtually flagged off an all women crew onboard MT (Motor Tanker) Swarna Krishna, a vessel of Shipping Corporation of India (SCI) from Jawaharlal Nehru Port Trust (JNPT) Liquid Berth Jetty. For the first time in the history of world maritime, a ship with only woman officers was sailed. Two days ahead of the International women’s day The Chatrapati Shivaji Maharaj Terminus in Mumbai, Maharashtra was lit up in pink to celebrate womanhood.

.....[1] Members of Parliament (Lok Sabha), was sworn in as the 9th Chief Minister(CM) of Uttarakhand following the resignation of.....[2] on 9th March 2021 following the unease over his governance. The Oath Taking Ceremony is administered by Governor, Baby Rani Maurya.[1] was a former pracharak of the Rashtriya Swayamseva Sangh (RSS). He was the first Education Minister of Uttarakhand when the state was formed in 2000. He was elected as the secretary general of the BJP’s Uttarakhand Unit in 2007. He was elected to the state assembly in 2012 and served as the chief of the BJP unit of Uttarakhand from 2013 to 2015.He was also an MLA from the Chaubattakhal constituency from 2012 to 2017. In 2019, He was elected to the 17th Lok Sabha as a Member of Parliament (Lok Sabha) from Garhwal, Pauri constituency.[2] handed his resignation to Baby Rani Maurya, Governor of Uttarakhand. He resigned days before completing his 4th year as CM amid the growing rebellion in the ranks against his decision to announce Gairsain as a new administrative division.[2] was chosen as the first Time CM by Prime Minister Narendra Modi following the landslide victory of BJP in the 2017 assembly election in which BJP won 57 seats of the 71 members assembly(70+ 1 Anglo Indian).[3] of Congress is the only CM of Uttarakhand to complete a full 5 year term since the formation of the state. He was a three-time Chief Minister of Uttar Pradesh (1976–77, 1984–85, 1988–89) and served once as Chief Minister of Uttarakhand (2002–2007). Between 1986 and 1988, he served in Prime Minister Rajiv Gandhi's cabinet, first as Minister for External Affairs and then as Minister of Finance. He served as Governor of Andhra Pradesh from 2007 until 2011.

The 39th edition of annual CERAWEEK Conference 2021 was held virtually for the first time where[1] was conferred with CERAWEEK Global Energy and Environment Leadership Award. CERA

stands for Cambridge Energy Research Associates (CERA).[1] addressed the CERAWeek Conference where he highlighted the following points: Target: India has set a target to boost the share of gas in its fuel mix to 15% from the current 6% by 2030. Major challenges: Climate change and calamities are major challenges which can be overcome by two ways viz. policies, laws, rules and orders; and behavioural change. India's forest cover and population of lions, tigers, leopards and waterfowls has been increased over the last seven years. United States(US) is a major supplier of LNG (Liquefied Natural Gas) to India. The award was Instituted in 2016, the award recognizes the commitment of leadership on the future of global energy & environment and for offering solutions and policies for energy access, affordability & environmental stewardship. Organized by IHS Markit, the sessions and themes of the conference were inspired by the new book titled 'The New Map: Energy, Climate and the Clash of Nations'. The book is written by IHS Markit Vice Chairman and CERAWeek Chairman Daniel Yergin. It was organized after two years as the 2020 conference was cancelled due to COVID-19 pandemic. It should be noted that the Saudi Arabian Oil Company Saudi Aramco aims to create a world-scale hydrogen business by 2030. Energy Transition Climate & ESG; The New Map of Geopolitics; Economic Recovery, Markets & Investment; Innovation & Technology; and Workforce of the Future. Prominent Speakers were United States special presidential envoy for climate[2]. He previously served as the 68th United States Secretary of State from 2013 to 2017 ; Co-chair of the Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation and founder of Breakthrough Energy Bill Gates; and President and CEO, Saudi Aramco, Amin Nasser. About CERAWeek Initiated in 1983 by Dr. Daniel Yergin, it has been organized annually in Houston, United States (US) in the month of March. It is considered as the world's premier annual energy platform.

The award was presented by the USA on the recommendation of a Multi Ethnic Advisory Task Force, headed by US Congressman Danny K. Davis. Vice President of the USA[2] , was also one among the recipients in the 9th Edition of Top 20 Global Women of Excellence award. The award was conferred, based on her contribution towards women's rights, gender parity, women empowerment and women equality.[1] after receiving the award, made a call to the global arena for creating a Gender Equal world & promote women in decision making at higher levels.[1] holds the portfolio of Governor of Telangana & Lieutenant Governor of Puducherry (Currently under President Rule). Governors of States are appointed based on the provision of Article[3] of Indian Constitution . President Ram Nath Kovind presented a barton of honour and a letter of appreciation to former Puducherry lieutenant governor[4] at Rashtrapati Bhavan, New Delhi. The Baton which is decorated with the emblem of the Indian Republic was given as a memento for recognizing[4] service in the Union Territory of Puducherry and to appreciate her constitutional duties

According to the Freedom in the World 2021: Democracy under Siege' released by US based Think Tank Freedom House, India has scored 67 and its position has been downgraded to 'Partly Free' from 'Free' in 2020. India's ranking has also fallen to[1] out of 211 countries. The 'most free countries' with a score of 100 are[2], Norway & Sweden. Least Free Countries with a score of 1 are Tibet & Syria. This is the 1st time since 1997 that India has been downgraded to 'partly free'. India's score has decreased from 71 (in 2020). Freedom House is largely funded through USA government grants and is actively tracking the course of democracy since 1941. Freedom House noted that the change in India's status from "Free" to "Partly Free" was the most significant for 2020, "meaning less than 20 per cent of the world's people now live in a Free country — the smallest proportion since 1995". India's score of 67 puts in on par with other countries like Ecuador & Dominican Republic. According to the 'Democracy Index 2020' released by the Economist Intelligence Unit (EIU), India with a score of 6.61 slipped two places to 53rd Rank (out of 167 countries) in the Index due to decline in Civil Liberties.

India with a score of 3.819 has been ranked[3] out of 149 countries in the 'World Happiness Report 2021' an publication of United Nations Sustainable Development Solutions Network. The rankings were topped by[4] (tops for the 4th time) followed by Denmark and Switzerland. This is the 9th World Happiness Report and is based on surveys conducted during the time period of 2018-20. It ranks the world's 149 countries on "how happy their citizens perceive themselves to be". The results of the report based on the Gallup World Poll. The least happy countries were Afghanistan (149), Zimbabwe (148) & Rwanda (147). Apart from Afghanistan (149), all neighbouring countries ranked higher than India. The survey was based on issues like (i) Effects of COVID-19 on structure and quality of people's lives, Performance of governments in dealing with the pandemic and The report also took into account data related per capita Gross Domestic Product, healthy life expectancy, social support, freedom to make life choices, generosity and corruption perception.

Indian Actor[1] received the FIAF Award 2021 by the International Federation of Film Archives (French: Fédération Internationale des Archives du Film, FIAF), an international organization of film archives and museums across the globe over a virtual award ceremony hosted from Mumbai, Maharashtra. The award was bestowed upon him by former FIAF Award recipients and filmmakers Martin Scorsese and Christopher Nolan.[1] became the first Indian to receive this award. He was nominated by the FIAF Affiliate Film Heritage Foundation, founded by filmmaker and archivist Shivendra Singh Dungarpur in 2014 to preserve the endangered Film heritage of India. The veteran Indian actor[1] became the ambassador of the Film Heritage foundation in 2015. Working with the film heritage foundation, He has contributed to the preservation of the Indian film heritage. He has received India's 3 highest civilian awards, Padma Shri (1984), Padma Bhushan(2001) and Padma Vibhushan(2015) for arts. He received the[2] Award, the highest honours of Indian Cinema in 2019. The FIAF Award was introduced in 2001 and the inaugural award was presented to American Martin Scorsese. The annual FIAF Award is presented to a film personality whose experience and personal contribution to the field of cinema are in line with the missions of the FIAF.

.....[3] Divisional Forest Officer, Athagarh Forest Division, Odisha received the United Nations's 2020 Asia Environmental Enforcement Awards under the category Impact and Gender Leadership. She became the first Indian to receive the award. The 2020 theme of the 5th edition Asia Environmental Enforcement Awards "Fighting Transboundary Environmental Crimes". Wildlife Crime Control Bureau of India won the award under Innovation category for initiating the operation WILDNET-II to deter traders and to bring offenders to justice. The awards recognises the excellence in enforcement by government of ficials and institutions or teams combating transboundary environmental crime. The award was presented by the United Nations Environment Programme (UNEP) in partnership with UNDP, UNDOC, the secretariat of CITES, INTERPOL and World Cust oms Organization.
