M Venkaiah Naidu, Vice President of India presented the Kalinga Ratna Samman for the year 2021 to
[2], governor of Andhra Pradesh(AP) to recognise his contribution to literature. The award was
presented during the 600th Birth Anniversary celebrations of Adi Kabi Sarala Das and the 40th Annual Day of
Sarala Sahitya Sansad at the Sarala Bhawan, Cuttack. Kalinga Ratna Samman is an annual award instituted by
the Sarala Sahitya Sansad in 2007. The award recognises the person of Odisha who has contributed to any
field at the national or international level. The award carries a silver idol of Goddess Saraswati, a copper
plaque and a shawl[2] was born on 3rd August 1934 in Godijhara village in Puri, Odisha. He was
elected to the Assembly of Odisha 5 times. He served as the Cabinet Minister in 2004. In July 2019, he was
appointed as the Governor of Andhra Pradesh. Some of his books are Matrubhasa, Bhasa Jhalaka, Rana
Pratap, Astasikha Manasi, Sangrama Sarinahi. Sarala Das was considered a genius in the field of Odia
literature. The "Sarala Mahabharat" written by Sarala Das in the 15th century is the first complete
Mahabharata in a regional language.
