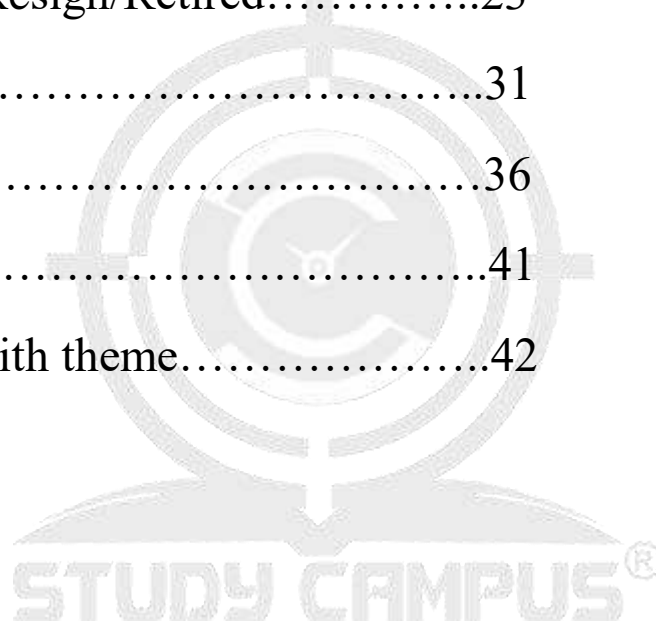

Infosys Becomes 4th Indian Company to Reach 100 Billion USD M-Cap

Infosys became the 4th Indian company and 2nd Indian software company after Tata Consultancy Services (TCS) to cross the 100 billion USD mark in terms of market capitalization (m-cap). TCS, Reliance Industries and HDFC bank are other Indian companies that have crossed the 100 billion mark in terms of m-cap.

NSO: India's GDP in Q1 FY22 Grow by 20.1%; Fiscal Deficit in April-July 2021 Reached 21.3%

As per the data of the National Statistical Office (NSO), Ministry of Statistics and Programme Implementation (MoSPI), India's Gross Domestic Product (GDP) in the first quarter of the financial year 2021-22 (Q1 FY22) (i.e. April to June 2021) grew by **20.1 percent** as compared to a contraction of 24.4 (-24.4) percent in Q1 FY21.



- **GDP at Constant Prices (2011-12):** It is estimated at Rs 32.38 lakh crore in Q1 FY22, as against Rs 26.95 lakh crore in Q1 FY21 (a growth of **20.1 percent**).
- **Gross Value Added (GVA) at Constant Prices:** It is estimated at Rs 30.48 lakh crore in Q1 FY22, as against Rs 25.66 lakh crore in Q1 of FY21 (a growth of **18.8 percent**).

Delhi Tops Forbes India's List of World's Most Surveilled Cities

Delhi tops the theForbers India Report on the **Most Surveilled Cities in the World** with 1,826.6 CCTV cameras per square(sq) mile. Delhi is followed by **London** with 1,138 and **Chennai** with 609.9 CCTV Cameras per sq miles in 2nd and 3rd spot respectively. Mumbai, Maharashtra has secured 18th spot with 157.4 cameras per sq miles.

Indian Army set to procure over 100 "SkyStriker" – a type of suicide drones

In September 2021, Indian Army signed a **Rs. 100 crore** worth contract with the Joint Venture between India's Alpha Design & Israel's Elbit Security Systems, for the procurement of over **100** – 'SkyStrikers' under its emergency procurement powers. All the 'SkyStriker' type drones will be manufactured in the Bangalore manufacturing unit of **Alpha Design**.



i. They are also known as "**Suicide Drones**", because of its autonomous system that is designed to directly crash over the target with its pre-loaded 5 kgs of Warhead.

ii. Previously in August 2021, Alpha Design signed 2 defence procurement contracts with the Indian Air Force (IAF).

Mumbai became First South Asian City To Launch CAP

State environment, tourism and protocol minister of Maharashtra, **Aaditya Thackeray** launched the first ever Climate Action Plan (CAP) for Mumbai, Maharashtra. Mumbai has become the **first South Asian city** to launch CAP. The CAP will ensure better planning and growth for climate resilient infrastructure and mitigation efforts.



Highlights

- i. Mumbai has joined **C-40 Cities Network** December 2020. By following the compliance with guidance of C-40, a CAP will be drafted.
- ii. BrihanMumbai Municipal Corporation (BMC) is developing the climate action plan and technical support is provided by the World Resource Institute of India.

About Mumbai Climate Action Plan(MCAP)

- i. It would have six thematic action areas such as sustainable waste management, urban greening and biodiversity, urban flooding and water resource management, building energy efficiency, air quality and sustainable mobility.
- ii. Assessment will be done by using satellite imagery data.

About C-40 Cities:

- i. C40 is a network of the world's megacities committed to addressing climate change. Chair of C40 – Eric Garcetti.
- ii. The cities from India that are part of the C40 are **Delhi NCT, Bengaluru, Chennai, Kolkata and Mumbai.** (Bengaluru is Temporarily Inactive).

1st Hurun India Future unicorn List 2021: India became world's 3rd largest startup ecosystem, after US & China

In accordance with the first **Hurun India Future unicorn List 2021'** released by Hurun Research Institute, India became the third largest Unicorn ecosystem in the world after the United States (US) and China as India have **51** Unicorns worth \$168 billion, and **32** Gazelles and **54** Cheetahs.

- This list is a ranking of India's startups founded in the 2000s, having a value of US\$200 million (Rs 1,500 crore), and have not yet been listed on the stock exchange.
- Number of Unicorns in the US and China is at 396 and 277 respectively. The United Kingdom (UK) is at 4th position with 32 unicorns and Germany at 5th spot with 18.

Union Minister Dharmendra Pradhan, Ministry of Education (MoE) released the **6th NIRF (National Institutional Ranking Framework) Rankings 2021** of Higher Educational Institutes (HEIs) of India in 11 categories from New Delhi.

ii.The ranking has been topped by IIT (Indian Institute of Technology) Madras, Tamil Nadu in the overall category which is followed by IISc (Indian Institute of Science) Bengaluru, Karnataka at 2nd and IIT Bombay, Maharashtra at 3rd place.

iii.All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS), New Delhi retains top slot in Medical for the 4th consecutive year.

DRDO handed over MRSAM to IAF; India's 1st Emergency Landing Facility of IAF Plane on NH inaugurated on NH925, Rajasthan

i. the Defence Research and Development Organisation (**DRDO**) handed over the **first deliverable Firing Unit (FU) of Medium Range Surface to Air Missile (MRSAM) "Barak-8"** System to Indian Air Force (**IAF**) at Air Force Station, Jaisalmer in Rajasthan.



ii.MRSAM (IAF) is an advanced network centric combat Air Defence System developed by DRDO in collaboration with Israel Aerospace Industries (IAI), and PPP (Public Private Partnership) in Indian industry.

iii.The Union Ministers Rajnath Singh and Nitin Jairam Gadkari, Ministry of Road Transport & Highways (MoRTH) inaugurated a 3-km emergency landing strip or Emergency Landing Facility (ELF) at **Satta-Gandhav stretch** on National Highway 925 in Barmer, Rajasthan for IAF planes. NH-925 is India's first national highway to be used as ELF of IAF aircraft.

iv.The ELF strip has been developed by **National Highways Authority of India (NHAI)** in association with IAF.

Medicines from the Sky project: Telangana became 1st Indian State to launch BVLoS drones to send medicines

i Union Minister **Jyotiraditya Scindia**, Ministry of Civil Aviation launched 'Medicines from the Sky (MFTS)' in Vikarabad district of Telangana to send medicines to primary healthcare centres using drones. With this Telangana became the first Indian state to use drones for Beyond Visual Line of Sight (BVLoS) to deliver the payload.



ii.MFTS is an initiative of the Government of Telangana led by the emerging technologies wing of Telangana's IT Department in association with **World Economic Forum (WEF)**, **NITI (National Institution for Transforming India)** Aayog, and **HealthNet**

Global (Apollo Hospitals).

Female Candidates allowed to attend NDA Exams

Indian Armed Forces allowed the entry of female candidates into the armed forces through National Defence Academy (NDA) after the intervention of the Supreme Court (SC) of India. Previously, a Supreme Court bench of justices Sanjay Kishan Kaul and Hrishikesh Roy, questioned the gender bias followed in the recruitment of candidates for the Indian Armed Forces.

- i. The NDA Exams that was set to be held on 5th September was postponed to 14th November after the intervention of the Supreme Court, and now female candidates were allowed to appear in the examination.
- ii. Previously, In February 2020, Female candidates serving in Short Service Commission (SSC) were permitted for Permanent Commission after similar intervention by the Supreme Court.

Note – During 2021 Republic Day, Bhawana Kanth & Swati Rathore became the 1st women pilots to participate in the Republic Day parade.

Aligarh Prime Minister (PM) Narendra Modi laid the foundation stone of Raja Mahendra Pratap Singh State University in Aligarh, Uttar Pradesh. Uttar Pradesh will establish the university in the memory of Jat social reformer Raja Mahendra Pratap Singh.

Highlights

- The University will have the department of modern defence studies, defence manufacturing- related technologies and manpower development.
- It will be spread over an area of 92 acres at Lodha village and Musepur Kareem Karouli village of Kol tehsil in Aligarh, it will provide affiliation to 395 colleges of the Aligarh division.



About Raja Mahendra Pratap Singh

i. Raja Mahendra Pratap Singh was born in a socio-economically influential Jat family of Mursan in Hathras, Uttar Pradesh 1886.

ii. He was a Jat freedom fighter, social reformist, journalist and writer. He served as the President in the **Provincial government of India**, the Indian government that served in exile during World War I.

iii. In 1979, the Government of India issued a **postage stamp** in his honour. He is popularly known as **Aryan Peshwa**.

iv. Singh was known as an **unofficial envoy of Afghanistan**.

Sansad TV Launched by Vice President, PM and Speaker of Lok Sabha

Vice President and Chairman of Rajya Sabha M. Venkaiah Naidu, Prime Minister Narendra Modi and Lok

Sabha Speaker Om Birla jointly launched ‘**Sansad**’ TV. The launch of Sansad TV coincides with **International Day of Democracy- 15th September** .

- The programming of this TV will primarily be in **four categories** – functioning of Parliament and democratic institutions, governance and implementation of schemes, policies, history, and culture of India and issues, interests, concerns of contemporary nature.

TCS Becomes 2nd Indian company to hit USD 200 Bn M-cap after RIL

Tata Consultancy Services (TCS) of TATA groups becomes the **2nd Indian** company to hit the **200 Billion USD** market capitalization (**M-Cap**) mark. Reliance Industries (RIL) was the first Indian Company to achieve the feat.

- Among the most valued software companies, TCS is ranked behind Accenture (USD 218bn) and ahead of IBM (USD 123 bn).
- TCS, which completes 50 years, listed on the stock exchanges in 2004, crossed the USD 50-Bn market value in December 2010, USD 100 Bn in April 2018 and USD 150 Bn in December 2020.



IRCTC Launched India’s 1st Indigenous Luxury Cruise Liner

Indian Railway Catering and Tourism Corporation (IRCTC) started **India’s first** indigenous luxury cruise liner on 18th September 2021.

IRCTC has partnered with **Cordelia Cruises**, operated by **Waterways Leisure Tourism Private Limited** to promote and market India’s 1st luxury cruise.



- The cruise will sail to national and international destinations like Goa Diu, Lakshadweep, Kochi and Sri Lanka.

Kovalam, Eden beaches get Blue Flag tag

Two more new Indian beaches– **Kovalam in Tamil Nadu** and **Eden in Puducherry** received Blue Flag Certification from Foundation for Environment Education in Denmark (FEE) in 2021. With this, India received a Blue tag for 10 beaches.

- It also issued re-certification for 8 nominated beaches Shivrajpur-Gujarat, Ghoghla-Diu, Kasarkod and Padubidri-Karnataka, Kappad-Kerala, Rushikonda- Andhra Pradesh, Golden-Odisha and Radhanagar- Andaman and Nicobar, which were awarded the Blue Flag certificate in 2020.

About Blue Flag Certificate

i. The Blue Flag is one of the world’s most recognised voluntary awards for beaches, marinas, and

sustainable boating tourism operators.

ii. It is issued by Foundation for Environment Education in Denmark (FEE) and international jury comprising of members from IUCN, UNWTO, UNEP and UNESCO etc.

iii. It started in 1987 and in 2001 European Blue Flag became International Blue Flag .

Law Minister Kiren Rijju Inaugurated India's 1st Sports Arbitration Centre in Gujarat

In September 2021, the Union Law Minister **Kiren Rijju** inaugurated India's 1st 'Sports Arbitration Centre of India' (SACI) in Gujarat. The SACI will serve as an independent body to redress the disputes in the sports sector and expand the country's sports sector.

- The Ministry of Law and Justice will provide all the legal backing to the SACI.
- The SACI will be promoted by Ahmedabad-based **SE TransStadia Pvt Ltd**. They will provide the centre and process, which will be governed by the international laws of sports.
- Under SACI, known independent arbitrators will be listed out by TransStadia and those arbitrators will settle the sports issues and they will be paid directly by the disputing parties.

Govt Dissolves Ordnance Factory Board, reorganizing to Seven Defence PSUs

As part of the Atmanirbhar Bharat (self-reliant India) to corporatize the production in Defence sector, Defence Ministry of India had dissolved the Ordnance Factory Board (OFB).

- **Ordnance Factory Board (OFB)** is an entity under the Department of Defence Production (DDP), Ministry of Defence (MoD) which supplies critical arms and ammunition to the three-armed forces and the paramilitary.



i. As per the announcement issued by the Government of India on May 16, 2020, the management, control, operations and maintenance of 41 production units and identified non-production units under OFB will be transferred to the wholly government owned **seven defence PSUs (Public Sector Units)** with effect from October 1, 2021.

ii. The employees of **OFB (Group A, B & C)** who are working in production and non-production units will be moved to the new DPSUs on terms of foreign service without any deputation allowance (deemed deputation) initially for a period of two years.

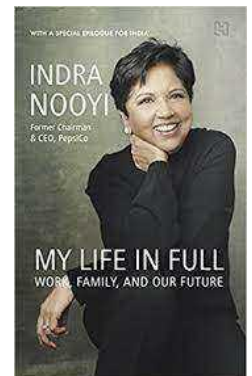
Seven new companies are:

- Troop Comforts Ltd. and Gliders India are reorganised for manufacturing textiles.
- Munitions India Ltd., India Optel Ltd., Armoured Vehicles Nigam Ltd., Advanced Weapons and Equipment India Ltd., and Yantra India Ltd. are into manufacturing machinery and equipment.

- i. IndraNooyi is an Indian-American business executive, who served as the chairperson and chief executive officer (CEO) of PepsiCo from 2006 to 2019.
- ii. She was the first woman of colour and an immigrant to head a Fortune 50 company.
- iii. She is serving as the director on the board of Amazon since 2019.
- iv. The government of India honoured her with **Padma Bhushan** in 2007 for trade and industry.

New Book ‘The Fractured Himalaya: India Tibet China 1949-1962’ by Nirupama Rao

Retired Indian Diplomat Nirupama Menon Rao (**Nirupama Rao**) has authored a new book titled ‘**The Fractured Himalaya: India Tibet China 1949-1962**’, which provides an understanding of India-China relations.

The book published by Penguin Viking, owned by Penguin Random House, is based on archival materials and her personal experience as India’s ambassador to China.

- Nirupama Menon Rao, 1973 batch IFS officer from Kerala, served as India’s Foreign Secretary (2009-2011).
- She was the 1st woman high commissioner from India to Sri Lanka and the 1st woman ambassador to the People’s Republic of China and also served as the Ambassador of India to the United States.

PM Modi Launches Ayushman Bharat Digital Mission to Promote Digital Health Infrastructure The Prime Minister (PM) Narendra Modi launched ‘**Ayushman Bharat Digital Mission**’ (ABDM) via video

conference. The program was organized on **World Tourism Day** (27th September). It was launched in the presence of Mansukh Mandaviya, Union Minister of Health and Family Welfare and Dr Bharati Pravin Pawar, Minister of State for Health and Family Welfare.



Objective – To develop the integrated digital health infrastructure of the country.

- Ayushman Bharat Digital Mission will provide a digital health ID to people which will contain their health records. This mission was launched under the pilot project National Digital Health Mission (NDHM).
- The mission was launched under the pilot project National Digital Health Mission (NDHM).
- It will help connect digital health solutions of hospitals across the country. All Indians will get a **digital health ID** under this scheme. Every citizen's health record will now be digitally secure.

About National Digital Health Mission (NDHM)

Launched – August 15, 2020.

i. The NDHM is implemented by the **National Health Authority (NHA)** under the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare.

ii. The NDHM is a complete **digital health ecosystem**. The digital platform will be launched with four key features — **health ID, personal health records, Digi Doctor** and **health facility registry**.

New Book Titled “The Three Khans: And the Emergence of New India” Authored by Kaveree Bamzai

- Kaveree Bamzai is an independent journalist who has worked with India Today, The Indian Express and The Times of India,
- She was the 1st and the only woman editor of India Today.

UNSC Adopts Resolution on Afghanistan Under India's Chair

United Nations Security Council (UNSC), the 15-Nation body has adopted a strong resolution on Afghanistan **under India's Presidency**. China & Russia abstained from voting on the resolution.



- The resolution demands not to use Afghan territory to threaten or attack any country or to shelter or train terrorists, or to plan or to finance terrorist acts.

Dubai gets Ain Dubai, World's largest & Tallest Observation Wheel

The World's largest and tallest observation wheel named '**Ain Dubai**' is set to be opened in Dubai, United Arab Emirates(UAE) on 21st October 2021. The ain Dubai is located at Bluewaters Island.

Hyundai Engineering & Construction and Starneth Engineering were the primary design and construction contractors of Ain Dubai.

The Ain Dubai is around 2 times taller than the London Eye, which will take the visitors to a **height of 250 meters**.

'Orca'- World's Largest Plant Capturing Carbon Dioxide From Air Starts In Iceland

The **World's Largest Plant** to Capture Carbon Dioxide(CO₂) from air, '**Orca**' Starts Operating in Iceland. The Plant will suck in CO₂ and store it underground in the form of rock. It was started by a Swiss startup **Climeworks AG** in partnership with Icelandic carbon storage firm **Carbfix**. The plant can capture up to **4,000 tons of CO₂ per year**.



About the Orca plant-

- The 'Orca' refers to the Icelandic word 'Orka' for meaning "energy". The plant consists of eight large containers similar in looks to those used in the shipping industry, which employ high-tech filters and fans to extract carbon dioxide.
- The plant has four units, each made up of two metal boxes.

Highlights

- According to the International Energy Agency (IEA), the global CO₂-emissions totalled 31.5 billion tonnes in 2020. Therefore this plant will help in sucking the polluted carbon from the atmosphere.

Mechanism

- For the collection of CO₂, the plant uses fans to draw air into the collector, which has filter material inside.
- Once the filter material is filled with CO₂, the collector is closed and the temperature is raised to release

the CO₂ from the material after which the highly concentrated gas can be collected.

iii. The CO₂ is then mixed with the water before being injected at a depth of 1,000 metres into the nearby basalt rock where it is petrified.

Accra of Ghana Named as the UNESCO's World Book Capital for 2023

Audrey Azoulay, Director-General of the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization (UNESCO) has named **Accra**, Capital of Ghana as the **UNESCO World Book Capital for 2023**, following the evaluation of the World Book Capital Advisory Committee.



- Accra is the 23rd city to be named the World Book Capital since 2001.
- The celebrations will start on 23rd April 2023, World Book and Copyright Day 2023.
- **Objective** – Cities designated as UNESCO World Book Capital undertake to promote books and reading for all ages and population groups, within and across national borders, and to organize a programme of activities for the year.

Note:

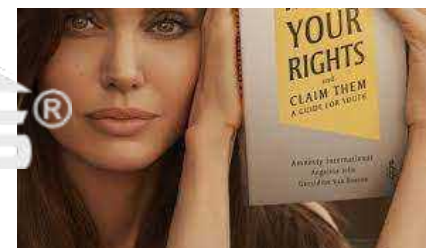
- Madrid (Spain) was the first city to be named the UNESCO World Book Capital in 2001.
- **Guadalajara** of Mexico was named the **World Book Capital of 2022**. Tbilisi, Capital of Georgia was named the World Book Capital of 2021.

Key Points:

- The city of Accra has been selected for its focus on young people and their potential contribution to the culture and wealth of Ghana.
- As the world book capital, Accra will promote the reading and writing of books in different Ghanaian languages.

Angelina Jolie has Written Child Rights Book titled 'Know Your Rights and Claim Them'

The book **"Know Your Rights and Claim Them: Guide for Youth"** is written by the Hollywood actress **Angelina Jolie** in collaboration with Human Rights lawyer **Geraldine Van Buren** and **Amnesty International**.



- The book is like a guide for every child and young person who access their rights.
- It talks about gender rights, racial equality, free expression, healthy environment and sustainable life.
- **Note** – Geraldine is one among the drafters of the United Nations Convention of the Child Right in 1989.

About Angelina Jolie

She is a Hollywood actress, works for human rights awareness, for children, women and other society. She is also working as a special envoy for UN Refugee agency UNHCR.

About Convention on the Rights of the Child (UNCRC)

- i. The CRC was adopted by the United Nations in 1989. It came into existence in 1990 after receiving the minimum of 20 ratifications. India ratified UNCRC on 11 December 1992.
- ii. It has been ratified by all members of the UN except for the United States. It is the most widely ratified human rights treaty in the history of the world.
- iii. The Convention on the Rights of the child defines a child as “every human being below the age of 18 years unless, under the law applicable, majority is attained earlier”.

AMUL Ranks 18th and France's 'Lactalis' Tops in Rabobank 2021 Global Dairy Report

As per the 2021's **Global Dairy Top 20 report** released by a Dutch multinational banking and financial services company **Rabobank**, the France based dairy major company – **'Lactalis'** became the World's number 1 dairy company in terms of market capital. Lactalis replaced Switzerland's Nestle, which remained as the global leader in the dairy sector for decades.



- Notably, India's well known co-operative brand '**AMUL**' under the cooperative body Gujarat Cooperative Milk Marketing Federation (**GCMMF**) also was placed at the **18th position**, from its previous 16th rank in 2020.
- Gujarat Cooperative Milk Marketing Federation (**GCMMF**) has become the **first Indian dairy Industry** to spot in the global top 20 list released by Rabobank. .

UAE, Bangladesh, Uruguay Joined as 1st Batch New Members of BRICS's NDB

On 2nd September, 2021 The New Development Bank (NDB) formerly known as 'BRICS Development Bank' which was set up by the BRICS (Brazil, Russia, India, China and South Africa) admitted



that **Uruguay, United Arab Emirates(UAE) and Bangladesh** joined as the **1st batch of new members of NDB**.

Key points-

- iii.El Salvador had purchased its first 400 Bitcoins. Bitcoin will help to prevent the remittance of banking transactions which will be processed by 1.5 million citizens living in other countries send money home.

The United States(US), United Kingdom(UK) and Australia established a trilateral security partnership named – “AUKUS” in order to strengthen diplomatic, security and defence cooperation in the **Indo-Pacific region**. The partnership was announced between the US President Joe Biden, UK Prime Minister Boris Johnson and Australian Prime Minister Scott Morrison in a virtual meeting.



Objective– To ensure peace and security in the Indo-Pacific region and key focus areas are cyber capabilities, artificial intelligence, quantum technologies, and additional undersea capabilities.

Highlights

- i. AUKUS is a trilateral partnership, which will provide exchange of technology, services, research and development and defence equipment.
- ii. It is the **first initiative** under which **Australia is acquiring nuclear-powered submarines** for its Royal Australian Navy (RNS). Australia remains committed to fulfilling all of its obligations as a non-nuclear weapons state, including regulations under the International Atomic Energy Agency (IAEA).
- iii. Australia’s nuclear-powered submarines, **when they deploy, will be armed with conventional weapons only and not nuclear weapons.**

Importance of the Alliance

The AUKUS and another alliance QUAD are formed with a vision for a safer and more secure Indo-Pacific. QUAD countries are the US and Australia formed alliance with India and Japan.

Note – US President Joe Biden will host the first-ever in person Quad Leaders Summit at the White House on 24 September 2021.

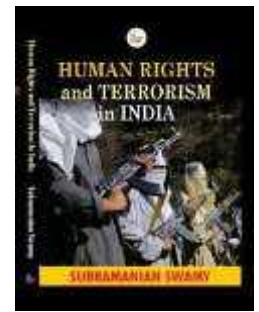

days long, Russia's Multi Nation Exercise **Zapad 2021** is conducting from 3rd to 16th September at Nizhniy in Russia. Indian Army took part in 'ZAPAD 2021' with 200 personnel mainly from the Naga Regiment participated as an all '**Arms Combined Task Force**' for the exercise, which is one of the theatre levels exercises of the Russian armed forces.

- The aim of the conducting exercise focuses primarily on operations against terrorists. More than dozen countries from Eurasia and South Asia will also participate in the same exercise. Zapad, meaning "west".
- One of the main event of **Russian-Belarusian strategic exercises** will be conducted between September 10-16 at nine sites in Russia, the Baltic Sea, and also five sites in Belarus.
- For the first time, Armenia participated in Russia's Zapad 2021 strategic drills, after the military defeat of 2020.
- The exercise met symbolic contingents from Armenia, Kazakhstan, Tajikistan, India, Kyrgyzstan, Serbia and Sri Lanka, and observers are to be sent by China, Vietnam, Myanmar, Pakistan and Uzbekistan.

i. India has launched its first satellite and nuclear-missile tracking ship INS (Indian Naval Ship) Dhruv. It is the first of its kind **ocean surveillance ship** (OSS) that is capable of tracking ballistic missiles at a long-range.

ii. It was launched by National Security Advisor **Ajit Doval** in the presence of Chief of Naval Staff Admiral Karambir Singh from Visakhapatnam (Andhra Pradesh), its commission site.

iii. It is built by the **Hindustan Shipyard Limited** (HSL) in collaboration with the DRDO (Defence Research and Development Organisation) and NTRO (National Technical Research Organisation).

ii. The SLBM was fired underwater from its newly commissioned **3,000 ton class DosanAhn Chang-ho submarine**.

iii. North Korea successfully test fired two short-range ballistic missiles from a train for the first time during a drill of its **Railway Mobile Missile Regiment**.

i.On September 23, 2021, the **Heavy Vehicles Factory (HVF)** of Avadi, Chennai (Tamil Nadu) grabbed Rs 7,523 crore order from the Ministry of Defence (MoD) for the supply of 118 Main Battle Tanks (MBTs) Arjun Mk-1A for the Indian Army. The tank is known as the “hunter killers”.

ii.It is a new variant of MBT Arjun Tank Mk-1A with 72 new features, more indigenous content, and numerous upgrades.

iii.MoD also promulgated a framework for enhanced and synergised utilization of simulators by the three (Army, Navy and Air Force) Services and the Indian Coast Guard (ICG).

- ii. For the first time, 9 judges took the oath of office at one go in the Supreme Court of India.
- iii. The appointment of the 9 Judges including 3 women, takes the total strength of judges of the Supreme court to **33** (including the Chief Justice of India (CJI)), the maximum possible strength of the Supreme Court is **34**.

Justice AM Khanwilkar Appointed as Chairman of SCLSC:

Justice AM Khanwilkar, the second senior-most judge in the Supreme Court, has been appointed as the **Chairman** of Supreme Court Legal Services Committee(SCLSC). He succeeded Justice Rohinton Fali Nariman(RF Nariman) who retired on 12th August 2021.

- iv. He won the 2017 Gujarat election by a record margin of 117,000 votes.

iii. He was re-elected as the PM of Canada in 2019 and again in 2021.

Parliament of Canada:

i. The parliament of Canada, the federal legislature of Canada, located at Parliament Hill in Ottawa consists of 3 parts, the Monarch, the Senate, and the House of Commons.

ii. The parliament consists of **443** seats which include **338** Members of Parliament (MP) elected by the people and **105** senators, appointed by the Governor-General to represent regions of the country.

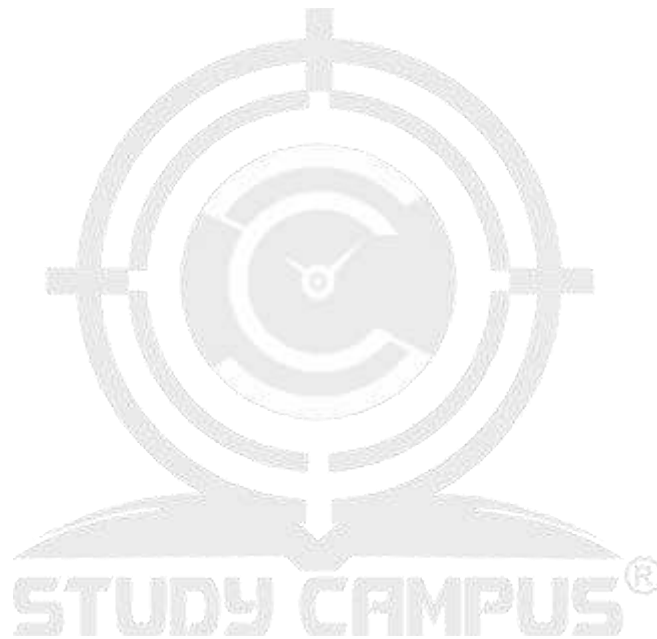

Princepal Singh Becomes 1st Indian to be a Part of NBA Championship Roster

Princepal Singh Bajwa from Punjab became the **first Indian** to be part of an **NBA title winning team** (at any level of the NBA) when his team Sacramento Kings won the 2021 NBA Summer League in Las Vegas in United States against the Boston Celtics.

- He signed a professional contract with NBA G League Ignite and became the 1st NBA Academy global alumni to sign a G League Contract and 1st ever NBA Academy India alumni to sign a professional contract.
- The win made the Sacramento Kings the only franchise to win multiple summer league titles.

Overview of 2020 Tokyo Paralympics

The Indian contingent has won a total of **19 medals** with **5 Golds, 8 Silvers and 6 Bronze medals** in the 16th edition of Summer Paralympic games that was held between 24th August and 5th September 2021 in Tokyo, Japan. The 19 medal count is higher than the total number of paralympics medals won by India in all the events since its 1st appearance in the **1968** Paralympic games.

- India has won a total of **12 medals from 1972 to 2016** in Paralympic games, where it had a highest total medal count of 4, both in 2016 and 1984.
- A total of 17 athletes have won 19 medals, with 2 athletes – **AvaniLekhara&SinghrajAdhana** have won **2 medals each**
- India was ranked **24th** in the overall medal tally with 19 medals, while the top 3 positions in the medal tally were occupied by **China**, Great Britain & USA.

Highlights:

- i. Shooter Avani Lekhara becomes first Indian woman to win gold at Paralympics.
- ii. Pramod Bhagat won the Gold medal in the men's singles SL3 class. This is India's first medal in badminton at the Paralympics Games.
- iii. Suhas Yathiraj – 1st ever IAS Officer to win Paralympic Medal.
- iv. Bhavinaben Patel creates history, Becomes 1st Indian para-paddler to win silver medal.

Guinness World Records Honoured Cristiano Ronaldo as Highest Scoring Man in International Football

Guinness World Records has honoured Portugal football player Cristiano Ronaldo for becoming the highest-scoring man in International football history with his 111th goal for Portugal against Ireland in a World Cup qualifier. This marked his 180th game representing Portugal.

- He has surpassed the record held by Iranian footballer Ali Daei who has scored 109 goals in 149 games for Iran between 1993 and 2006.
- Cristiano Ronaldo achieved the feat of scoring goals for Portugal between 2003 and 2021 over a period of 18 years.

**Note:**

Ronaldo and Daei are the only men to score more than 100 goals for their countries.

About Cristiano Ronaldo:

- i. Cristiano Ronaldo, the captain of the Portugal National football team, has represented the Premier League club Manchester United and Real Madrid.
- ii. He became the first player to score in five different editions of the continental tournament, taking his haul to 11 to overtake Michel Platini's record of nine goals at Euros.
- iii. With 137 goals he became the top scorer in the history of the champions league.

Beijing 2022 Winter Olympics Unveils Official Motto: Together for a Shared Future

The organisers of the **Beijing 2022** announced the official **motto** of Winter Olympic and Paralympic Games 2022, **"Together for a Shared Future"** over a ceremony at the Capital Museum, Beijing.

- The motto highlights unity and a collective effort, embodying the core values and vision of the Olympic Movement and the aim of pursuing world unity, peace and progress as well as the vision of the Paralympic Games.

18-year old **Emma Raducanu** from Britain defeated Canada's Leylah Fernandez to win the Women's Singles Title in the 2021 US Opens tournament. She became the youngest female to win a Grand Slam Title since Maria Sharapova's 2004 Wimbledon victory.

Alexandrovich Nepomniachtchi. This marks Magnus Carlsen's 3rd consecutive title in Norway chess and 4th overall title.

Norway Chess 2021, a 6-player double round-robin tournament was held from 7th to 17th September 2021 in Stavanger, Norway.



- Grandmaster **Alireza Firouzja** (Iranian-French Chess Player) finished 2nd by defeating Hungarian grandmaster Richárd Rapport.
- Richárd Rapport finished 3rd in the Norway Chess 2021.

About Norway Chess:

i. Norway chess started in 2012 is one of the world's most prestigious chess tournaments annually hosting a tournament with the global top players.

ii. This is an annual super tournament for the highest-ranked chess players in the world.

FIDE ranking:

i. **Magnus Carlsen** tops the September ranking of FIDE (International Chess Federation) followed by Fabiano Caruana of the USA (2nd) Liren Ding of China (3rd). Indian Grandmaster Viswanathan Anand is ranked 17th.

ii. Among women players, China's Yifan Hou tops the list followed by Aleksandra Goryachkina of Russia (2nd) and Humpy Koneru of India (3rd).

India's Gukesh D won Norway Open 2021 Masters:

Indian Grandmaster **Gukesh D** won the Norway Chess open 2021 under the masters' section and won 60000 (Norwegian Krone) NOK (around Rs 509000).

- This marks his 2nd consecutive win in a month.
- Gukesh's ranks 18th in FIDE's Juniors September ranking.

Indian Grandmaster **Iniyan P** secured the second position with 7½/10 points, finishing a half-point ahead of Dmitrij Kollars (Germany) and Valentin Dragnev (Austria).

- Iniyan P has won 40000 NOK (around Rs 339000).

Pankaj Advani won IBSF 6-Red Snooker World Cup 2021 in Doha; his 24th World Title

Indian snooker player **Pankaj Advani** won his **24th world title** by winning the International Billiards and Snooker Federation (IBSF) **6-Red Snooker World Cup 2021** by defeating Pakistan player and 2017 World Team Snooker Champion **Babar Masih**.



- The IBSF 6-Red Snooker World Cup 2021 was organised by IBSF in association with Qatar Billiards and Snooker Federation held from 17th to 21st September 2021 in Doha, Qatar.
- The total prize money of 6-Red Snooker World Cup 2021 is 38000 USD which includes the winner's prize of 12000 USD.

L Hamilton become first F1 driver in history to seal 100 wins

Lewis Hamilton sets a new record by registering his 100th win after finishing first in **Russian Grand Prix** held at Sochi Autodrom in Russia on September 28. Hamilton is a British racer, competes for Mercedes.



- With this win, Hamilton became the first Formula-one driver in the history to reach 100 wins. Max Verstappen finished second at **Russian Grand Prix 2021**.

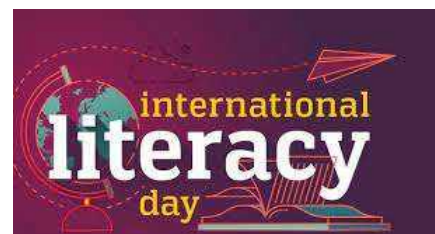
The day also aims to advance the literacy agenda towards a more literate and sustainable society.

- The National Engineers day 2021 marks the **160th** birth anniversary of Sir Mokshagundam Visvesvaraya who was born on 15th September 1861 in Muddenahalli village, Karnataka.

Background:

i. The government of India declared the birth anniversary of Sir Mokshagundam Visvesvaraya as National Engineers day.

ii. The first-ever National Engineers Day was observed on 15th September 1968.

International Day of Peace 2021 – September 21

The United Nations (UN)'s **International Day of Peace** is annually observed across the globe on **September 21st** to strengthen the idea of peace both within and among all nations and people by observing 24 hours of non-violence and cease-fire.

The theme of the International Day of Peace 2021 is **“Recovering better for an equitable and sustainable world”**.

- The 2021 theme focuses on the efforts of the UN on recovering better for a more equitable and peaceful world.

Background:

i. The United Nations General Assembly (UNGA) adopted the resolution A/RES/36/67 in 1981 and declared that the 3rd Tuesday of September, the opening day of the regular session of the UNGA as the International Day of Peace.

ii. The first ever International Day of Peace was observed on 14th September 1982.

iii. In September 2001, the UNGA adopted the resolution A/RES/55/282 and proclaimed the 21st September of every year as the International Day of Peace and the resolution also declared the International Day of Peace (September 21) as a period of non-violence and cease fire.

World Tourism Day – 27 September

The

United Nations (UN)'s **World Tourism Day (WTD)** is annually observed across the globe on **27th September** to create awareness about the importance of tourism and its impact on social, economic and political aspects of a region. The day also highlights the contributions of the tourism sector towards achieving Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs).



WTD 2021:

The United Nations World Tourism Organization (UNWTO) has designated World Tourism Day 2021 as a day to focus on “**Tourism for Inclusive Growth**” as the COVID-19 pandemic has had a massive social and economic impact on both developed and developing countries.

i. The **first** World Tourism Day was observed on **27th September 1980**.

Why September 27?

September 27th was chosen to commemorate the adoption of UNWTO statutes on 27th September 1970.
