

## Reliance Jio second-strongest telecom brand in world, says report

- **Reliance Jio** has climbed up to number two rank up from fifth place last year in a list of the top **10 strongest telecom brands** in the world.
- **Swisscom** increased brand value by 5 percent to \$6.3 billion and is the strongest telecoms brand with a Brand Strength Index (BSI) score of 92.
- Indian brand Jio is the second-strongest telecoms brand having a brand strength index score of 90/100 and earning an elite **AAA**+ **rating.** It increased its brand value up to 6 percent to \$5.4 billion; a two-point rise from last year.

## Two Australian Universities to set up Campuses in Gujarat's GIFT City

- Union Education Minister **DharmendraPradhan** announced that two Australian universities Wollongong and Deakin are set to establish campuses in Gujarat's 'GIFT City'.
- The two universities will sign an agreement on setting up their campuses during Australian **Prime Minister Anthony Albanese's** maiden visit to India next week.

## 'Catch the Rain 2023' campaign to be launched by President Murmu


- The 'Catch the Rain 2023' campaign was introduced by President DroupadiMurmu in New Delhi. The campaign's central idea is the sustainability of drinking water sources.
- Addressing at the ceremony, the **President** stated that since India only has 4% of the world's water resources, water management and conservation are India's most pressing challenges.
- **President DroupadiMurmu** claimed that due to uncontrolled urbanisation, traditional methods of water conservation have been abandoned in the nation.
- The President emphasised that these issues—water scarcity and global warming—are consequences of it.

## Gold Deposits Found at Different Location in Three Districts of Odisha

- Steel and Mines Minister Prafulla Kumar Mallik has informed the state Assembly that **Gold deposits** have been found at different locations in three districts of **Odisha**, including Deogarh, Keonjhar, and Mayurbhanj.
- The Minister informed that the State Directorate of Mines and geology and the **Geological Survey of India** (GSI) conducted a preliminary survey and found the presence of gold deposits in the Adas area of Deogarh, Gopur, Gazipur, Kusakala, Adal, Saleikana, Dimirimunda, and Karadanga area of Keonjhar.

## Select central govt employees get one-time option to opt for old pension scheme

• In a major move, a select group of **central government employees** have been given a onetime option to opt for **old pension scheme**, according to a Personnel Ministry order. The employees who joined the **central government services** against posts advertised or notified before December 22, 2003, the day **National Pension System (NPS)**

(Pension) Rules, 1972 (now 2021), said the order. This option may be exercised by the government servants concerned latest by August 31, 2023. The move came following various representations/references and court decisions in this regard, it said.

## 23rd Commonwealth Law Conference begins in Goa

- The 23rd Commonwealth Law Conference was inaugurated by Goa Governor P.S. SreedharanPillai.
- The five-day conference, which is being held from March 5-9, 2023, attended by Union Minister for also Law was and Justice KirenRijiju and Chief Minister of Goa Dr.PramodSawant.
- The Conference has 500 delegates from 52 countries in attendance.

## Uttarakhand'sRudraprayag, Tehri top landslide index: ISRO report

- Rudraprayag and Tehri the two districts in Uttarakhand are facing the highest risk of landslides, according to satellite data collected over the past two decades.
- Data collected by the Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO) has highlighted that Rudraprayag and TehriGarhwal are at the highest risk of facing landslides, having seen the highest number of landslide incidents in the past 20 years.

## 'Mundaka Upanishad: The Gateway to Eternity', written by former MP Dr. Karan Singh, is released

- Vice President JagdeepDhankhar announced the released of the book "Mundaka Upanishad: The Gateway to Eternity". Dr. Karan Singh, a former member of parliament, wrote the book at Upa-RashtrapatiNivas in New Delhi. He is a philosopher and politician from India.
- BhartiyaVidyaBhavan initially released this book in 1987. But, the current edition is unique since it includes Dr. Kamal Kishor Mishra's Hindi translation of Dr. Karan Singh's texts, who also

transliterated the Sanskrit text in accordance with international standards.

## PM Modi inaugurates world's longest railway platform in Hubballi, Karnataka

- Prime Minister NarendraModi dedicated World's longest railway platform of 1.5 kilometres at Sri Siddhaarooda railway station in Hubballi in the state of Karnataka.
- The inauguration of the platform was done during the PM's Karnataka visit in the presence of Union Minister Pralhad Joshi.
- It is to be noted that Indian Railways, South Western Railway Zones Hubbali is now registered in the Guinness Book of World Records for having the longest platform.









## Bengaluru-Mysuru expressway National Highway, Background and Facts

- On March 12, 2023, Prime Minister NarendraModi dedicated the Bengaluru-Mysuru Expressway to the country.
- The 118-km-long project will cut the distance between **Bengaluru** and **Mysuru's** travel time from nearly three hours to just over 75 minutes.
- The NH-275 segment between **Bengaluru**, **Nidaghatta**, and **Mysuru** will have six lanes constructed as part of the project, which has a total development cost of about Rs 8,480 crores.

## NitinGadkari unveiled first methanol run buses in Bengaluru

- The first methanol-powered buses in Bengaluru will be unveiled by Union Minister for Road
   and Transport, NitinGadkari.
- The Bengaluru Metropolitan Transport Corporation (BMTC), NITI Aayog, Indian Oil Company (IOC), and Ashok Leyland are working together to carry out the initiative, which aims to lower the level of pollutants.
- A top BMTC official informed that MD15 (diesel with 15% methanol) bus pilot testing will begin around 5:30 pm from VidhanaSoudha.
- The BMTC intends to launch 80 buses that will use methanol fuel as part of the trial project, and 20 Ashok Leyland buses will also be introduced in the first stages.
- The Indian Oil Company will offer free fuel and methanol for three months as part of the experiment.

## A new initiative called 'beggar-free city' started in Nagpur, Maharashtra

- In Nagpur, Maharashtra, a new project known as "beggar-free city" has been launched. Amitesh Kumar, the Nagpur City commissioner of police, announced that notification 144 CrPC has been issued in this regard.
- The social welfare division of the Nagpur Municipal Corporation (NMC) and the Nagpur City Police are partners in this effort. In order to accommodate homeless people in its shelters, the NMC has developed particular provisions.

## India 8th most polluted country in the world: Swiss firm IQAir Report

- According to the 'Global Air Quality' study published by the Swiss company IQAir, India fell from the fifth to the eighth most polluted nation in the world in 2022.
- The research shows that the PM2.5 level in the most polluted Indian cities is 53.3. The two Indian cities that made the list of the most polluted cities in the world are Bhiwadi, which is a suburb of Delhi, and Delhi, which was not far behind at 92.6.
- At the same time, 39 out of 50 cities in the list of most polluted cities are from India.









## AAHAR 2023: Asia's biggest International Food and Hospitality Fair begins in Delhi

- The objective of Aahar 2023, which was put together with the help of the Union Ministry of Food Processing Industries, the Agriculture and Processed Food Produacts **Export Development** Authority (APEDA), and other organisations, is to showcase the hospitality industry's potential and showcase technologies, goods, and services to both domestic and foreign consumers.
- The greatest four-day culinary event in India is called Aahar 2023, where wholesalers, caterers, hoteliers, and restaurant owners gather to source the best food, hospitality, and equipment as well as to assess industry trends.



At the fair's major event, Culinary Art India, WACS-certified jury members from India and overseas will also assess the skill of more than 500 cooks.

## SIPRI report 2023: India world's largest arms importer

- India is still the world's largest importer of military equipment, despite an 11% decline in arms purchases between 2013–17 and 2018–22, according to a study by the Stockholm International Peace Research Institute (Sipri).
- The report is released at a time when India has intensified its efforts to become self-reliant in the defence manufacturing sector.
- This year's defence budget included about Rs 1 lakh crore for domestic purchases, compared to Rs 84,598 crore, Rs 70,221 crore, and Rs 51,000 crore in the three years prior.



## National Company Law Tribunal (NCLT) approves HDFC and HDFC Bank merger

- On March 17th, the National Company Law Tribunal (NCLT) approved the merger of HDFC Ltd and HDFC Bank, which is considered to be the largest merger in the history of corporate India.
- The merger will create a massive banking entity by combining India's largest housing finance company with the country's largest private lender.
- Prior to this, HDFC Ltd had already received approval from various regulatory bodies and stock exchanges for the merger.

Shares of both companies were trading higher on the BSE during late trading hours.

## Delhi airport adjudged best airport in South Asia: Skytrax

- Skytrax, a UK-based consultancy, awards airports worldwide with the prestigious World Airport Awards based on customer surveys.
- For the fifth year in a row, Delhi's Indira Gandhi International Airport (IGIA) has been declared the best airport in the South Asian region.
- The IGIA is an international airport and has received this recognition due to its excellent facilities and services provided to customers.

## Literacy rate in India: Bihar lowest at 61.8%, Kerala highest at 94%

- According to the data shared by the Ministry of Education, Bihar (61.8 %) has the **lowest literacy**, followed by Arunachal Pradesh (65.3 %) and Rajasthan (66.1 %).
- **Kerala** has the highest literacy rate in India at 94%, followed by Lakshadweep at 91.85% and Mizoram at 91.33%.
- The literacy rate in rural India is 67.77 per cent as compared to 84.11 per cent in urban India.

- RachnaBiswatRawat, a journalist and writer from India, has recently written a book called "Bipin: The Man Behind the Uniform."
- The book is published by Penguin Veer, a Penguin Random House imprint, and focuses on the life, personality, and principles of General BipinRawat.
- Rawat was India's first Chief of Defence Staff and one of the country's most notable military leaders until he tragically died in a helicopter crash in 2021.
- The book was presented to India's Minister of Defence, Rajnath Singh, by the author. It serves as a fitting tribute to General Rawat's life and achievements.

## 'World Trade Center' To Come Up In Kolkata's Salt Lake: Merlin Group

- Merlin Group has partnered with the World Trade Centers Association to develop a World
- **Trade Center in Kolkata** that will cover an area of 3.5 million square feet.
- The project's License Agreement was signed by Scott Wang, Vice President of the World Trade Centers Association (WTCA) Asia Pacific region, and Merlin Group's Chairman, SushilMohta, and Managing Director, SaketMohta.
- The project, which is being built in Salt Lake, West Bengal, is estimated to require an investment of approximately Rs 1,500 crore.
- The oldest World Trade Center in India is located in Mumbai, and there are additional Centers in Bangalore, Chennai, New Delhi, Noida, Pune, and other cities.

## The World Happiness Report 2023: India ranked 126

- The 2023 World Happiness Report has been released, and it shows that Finland remains the happiest country in the world for the sixth year in a row.
- Denmark, Iceland, Israel, and the Netherlands are the next happiest countries, with other European countries such as Sweden, Norway, Switzerland, and Luxembourg also making the top 10.
- The rankings are based on data from the main life evaluation question in the **Gallup World Poll**, which measures how happy citizens perceive themselves to be.

## Ranveer Singh named India's most valuable celebrity of 2022

- According to a report by **Kroll**, a corporate investigation and risk consulting firm, actor **Ranveer Singh** has been named **India's most valuable** celebrity of 2022, surpassing cricketer **ViratKohli** who held the top spot for five years.
- The report titled "Celebrity Brand Valuation Report 2022: Beyond the Mainstream" reveals that Singh's brand value is **\$181.7 million.**
- ViratKohli, who previously held the top spot, has fallen to the second position with a brand value of **\$176.9 million**, according to the Kroll report.
- Kohli's brand value has been decreasing for the past two years since he resigned as the captain of the Indian men's cricket team.
- In 2020, his brand value was over \$237 million but steeply declined in 2021 to \$185.7 million, resulting in his current second-place ranking.


## Hurun Global Rich List: India ranks third in terms of self-made billionaires

- According to the 2023 M3M Hurun Global Rich List, **India** is ranked **third** in terms of the number of billionaires. However, China has almost five
- number of billionaires. However, China has almost five times more billionaires than India.
- The list shows that India has 105 self-made billionaires, ranking third in this category. The combined wealth of these billionaires is \$381 billion, according to the Hurun list.
- India's proportion of the world's billionaires has been consistently rising over the past five years, and it now









accounts for 8% of the total global billionaire population, compared to 4.9% five years ago. Among these billionaires, 57% are self-made.

- In the latest preview of Bing and Edge, Microsoft has added a new functionality called 'Bing Image Creator', which enables users to generate an image based on their written description by utilizing an enhanced version of Open AI's DALL-E model.
- Microsoft has announced the deployment of **Bing Image Creator** to Bing preview users via Bing chat, as well as the availability of the feature in Microsoft Edge for both desktop and mobile users worldwide in English.

#### Anurag Behar authors the New Book "A Matter of the Heart: Education in India"

- Anurag Behar, the CEO of AzimPremji Foundation and founding vice-chancellor of AzimPremji University, has authored a new travel book titled "A Matter of the Heart: Education in India".
- The book is a collection of 110 stories, based on Behar's experiences working at the foundation, and sheds light on the state of education in India beyond the major cities.
- Through his writing, Behar pays tribute to the educators who are shaping the future of the country.
- The book has been published by Westland Nonfiction, which is a division of Nasadiya Technologies Pvt Ltd.
- Behar is a well-known educationist and leader in India's social sector.

## Finance Bill 2023 passed in LokSabha

- The LokSabha passed the **Finance Bill 2023**, which implements tax proposals for the upcoming fiscal year, without any discussion.
- The passage of the Bill occurred amid Opposition uproar over the Adani controversy.
- Proposals for a total of **64 official amendments** were put forward in the Bill, including one that aims to eliminate long-term tax benefits for specific categories of debt mutual funds and another that calls for the establishment of the **GST Appellate Tribunal**.

- Titled 'Azaad', the book chronicles Azad's political journey and provides insights into the significant political changes that India has undergone over the past five decades.
- Published by Rupa Publications India, 'Azaad' is a candid account of Azad's life and career, including his interactions with influential leaders in India and around the world.



## Cheetah Sasha dies due to kidney ailment in MP's Kuno National Park

• A Namibian Cheetah passed away at **Kuno National Park** in MP, India.



- The cheetah, named **Sasha**, was reportedly in good health when it was moved to India on **September 17th 2022**, but it was discovered that it had a **kidney infection**.
- This event was a setback for the project aimed at rejuvenating the cheetah population in the country.

## BCCI Announces Herbalife as its Official Partner for TATA IPL 2023

- Herbalife, a leading global nutrition company, has teamed up with the Board of Control for Cricket in India (BCCI) to become an official partner of the TATA Indian Premier League (IPL) for the 2023 season.

- The TATA IPL 2023 is set to take place in India from March 31 to May 28, 2023.

## Passport Index points: India ranks at 144th spot in 2023

- According to the latest update from the **Passport Index, India's** Mobility Scores have decreased, resulting in the country experiencing the largest global drop on the Index this year.
- Prior to the pandemic in 2019, India had a mobility score of 71, which increased to 73 in 2022 as the post-pandemic wave of increasing mobility took effect.
- However, as of March 2023, its mobility score has dropped to 70.
- This decline has occurred despite record increases in mobility as the global and national economies re-opened after the pandemic.
- India's ranking has fallen by six places in 2023, resulting in an individual ranking of **144 compared to 138 in 2022.**



#### For the first time in the country, the decision on bail in the case of 'murder' with the help of ChatGPT

- The **Punjab** and **Haryana Court** recently utilized the assistance of an AI chatbot called **ChatGPT** to make a decision regarding a bail application in a criminal case, marking the first time an Indian court has done so.
- The bench, led by **Justice AnoopChitkara**, requested feedback from ChatGPT during the hearing of the bail petition filed by an individual who was taken into custody in June 2020 for **charges of criminal conspiracy**, murder, rioting, and criminal intimidation.

Jaipur to get India's 2nd largest cricket stadium named after Anil Agarwal

- Vedanta's Hindustan Zinc Limited (HZL) has signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with the Rajasthan Cricket Association to build the world's third-largest cricket stadium in Chonp village, Jaipur.
- This project involves an investment of **INR 300 crore**, making it one of the largest corporate investments in India's sports infrastructure.
- The stadium will be named the Anil Agarwal International Cricket Stadium, Jaipur.

## Australia's Deakin University to set up campus in GIFT city

- The first foreign university to establish a campus in India University of Australia. The autonomous campus will be built in Gujarat International Financial Tec-City (GIFT) City.
- While visiting **Ahmedabad**, Australian Prime Minister **Anthony Norman Albanese** is anticipated to make the official announcement.
- According to the **QS World University Rankings**, Deakin University is ranked 266 overall. It is one of the top 50 new universities worldwide.



• At least two Australian institutions are considering opening campuses in India.

## Singapore Airlines receives 25.1% stake in Air India group after investing \$267 mn

- Singapore Airlines will give Air India an additional SGD 360 million (USD 267 million).
- With its acquisition by **Tata** and merger with **Vistara Airlines**, it will give SIA a 25.1% interest in the firm.
- Through this deal, SIA will strengthen its relationship with Tata and gain an instant strategic position in a company that is four to five times bigger than **Vistara** in terms of size. Last year, **Tata** and **Singapore Airlines** both committed to provide additional funding if necessary to assist **Air India** reach its previous peak, when the airline had a glitzier shine, and sustain it.



• Once the brands are amalgamated, **Singapore Airlines** will own a quarter of a company that will have 218 aircraft and have access to high-paying parking and landing slots all over the world.

## Vistara Brand To Be Discontinued With Air India Merger

- Air India, owned by the Tata group, will discontinue the Vistara brand on completion of its merger with Tata SIA Airlines Ltd, the operator of Vistara airline, chief executive and managing director Campbell Wilson said. Tata Group owns a 51 per cent stake and Singapore Airlines the rest in Vistara.
- The full-service carrier will be known as Air India only, which is a much more recognisable brand outside India. Some of Vistara's heritage would be retained in that 'new manifestation', said Wilson.

## Elon Musk reclaims to the top, becomes richest person on the planet again

- Elon Musk, CEO of Tesla, once again overtook the position of richest person in the world on February 28, according to a Bloomberg Billionaires Index report.
- The second-placed French business tycoon **Bernard Arnault** has a net worth of \$185 billion, trailing **Tesla CEO Elon Musk** by \$187 billion.
- With a net worth of \$117 billion, Amazon Executive Chairman Jeff Bezos ranks third in terms of wealth.
- The strong increase in Tesla stock price, which rose to 92% in 2023 and outpaced the Nasdaq 100 rally so far in 2023, has been cited as the cause of the jump in Musk's wealth.
- The increase in the **Nasdaq** 100 Index so far this year is 11%.



## Japan, U.S., South Korea, Taiwan launch 'Chip 4' talks for supply chain

- Japan, the United States, South Korea and Taiwan have held the first meeting of senior officials
- under a new U.S.-led framework to help ensure a stable **supply of semiconductors**, Japan's industry ministry said.
- Officials from industry organizations in the four economies took part in the virtual conference of the "Chip 4" alliance on Feb. 16 to discuss ways to maintain supply chain resilience in times of natural disasters and other contingencies.
- In a bid to outcompete **China** technologically, the Biden administration launched a new dialogue forum with Japan and

South Korea on **friend-shoring semiconductors** as it invites companies to compete for a share of the \$50 billion already approved to revitalize the U.S. chip industry.

- The inaugural meeting of the **Economic Security Dialogue** among the United States, Japan and South Korea was launched in Honolulu.
- Japan and South Korea are home to two of the world's strongest semiconductor industries, and the forum aims to address issues related to critical and emerging technologies, supply chain resilience of semiconductors, batteries and critical minerals, as well as data transparency amid the **U.S.-China tech war**.

## The Windsor framework: The deal between UK and EU

- After months of intensive talks, the United Kingdom and European Union have unveiled an agreement on the Northern Ireland Protocol, called the Windsor Framework.
- This is not a new protocol or a fundamental rewrite of the current treaty. But the package announced this week is an improved deal that could substantively ease how the protocol will operate for businesses as well as individuals.
- It is a negotiating achievement that marks a turning point in the long road since **Brexit** for Northern Ireland.

## Ales Bialiatski, Nobel laureate sentenced prison for 10 years in Belarus

- Ales Bialiatski, a leading defender of human rights in Belarus and a candidate for the 2022 Nobel Peace Prize, was given a 10-year prison term in Minsk, the Capital of Belarus.
- Ales Bialiatski and three other key members of the Viasna human rights organisation he created were found guilty of funding rallies against the government.
- After widespread protests over a 2020 election that delivered autocratic President AleksandrLukashenko a second term in office, they were detained and imprisoned.
- Since taking government in 1994, **Lukashenko** has repressed dissent and cracked down on independent media.

## Scientists confirm existence of a fifth layer in Earth's core

- Researchers trying to uncover the secrets of **Earth's geology** have revealed the **fifth layer of the planet**.
- Seismic waves generated by earthquakes have revealed new insights about the deepest parts of Earth's inner core. The fifth layer is made of **iron and nickel**, the same materials that comprise the rest of the inner core.





- The team of researchers from the **Australian National University** measured the speeds at which these seismic waves penetrate and pass through the **Earth's inner core**.
- The team believes that this has presented evidence of a distinct layer inside Earth known as the innermost inner core.
- The existence of an internal metallic ball within the inner core, the innermost inner core, was hypothesised about 20 years ago.

#### Why is Indonesia moving its capital from Jakarta to Borneo?

- **Indonesia** is all set to move its capital from **Jakarta** to **Borneo** over environmental issues such as being congested, sinking into seawater, and being prone to earthquakes.
- Officials said the new metropolis city will be a "sustainable forest city," that puts the environment at the heart of the development and will be carbon neutral by 2045.
- Indonesian President JokoWidodo envisions the construction of the new capital as a "nostrum for the problems in Jakarta, which will also allow the country to start afresh."

## Silicon Valley Bank Collapse: The Biggest Bank Failure Since 2008


- Startup-focused lender Silicon Valley Bank Financial Group became the largest bank to fail since the 2008 financial crisis, in a sudden collapse that roiled global markets, left billions of dollars belonging to companies and investors stranded.
- Silicon Valley Bank, the nation's **16th largest bank**, collapsed on Friday, forcing a government takeover and calling into question the fate of almost \$175 billion in customer deposits.
- **Signature Bank**, the 29th-largest bank in the U.S., also closed its doors, suggesting the financial panic had spread.
- Many bank stocks plummeted in early trading. First **Republic Bank** dropped 65% before trading was halted; Western Alliance Bancorp fell almost 60%. Charles Schwab, the eight-largest U.S. bank, dropped nearly 10%.

## Earthquake of magnitude 7.1 strikes New Zealand's Kermadec Island

- An **earthquake** of 7.1 magnitude struck the New Zealand's Kermadec Islands region, the US Geological Survey (USGS) said.
- The **earthquake** was estimated at a depth of 10 km (6.21 miles). The US Tsunami Warning System has issued a tsunami warning following this earthquake.
- Reports in the **New Zealand** media are suggesting issuance of relevant rescue measures to prevent further mishappenings.

## ICC issues arrest warrant for Vladimir Putin over Ukraine war crimes

- The International Criminal Court (ICC) issued an arrest warrant for Russian President Vladimir Putin over the forced transfer of children to Russia after the Kremlin's invasion of Ukraine.
- Ukrainians accuse Russia of attempting genocide against them and seeking to destroy their identity partly through deporting children to Russia.







• The ICC issued the warrant for Putin's arrest on **suspicion of unlawful deportation of children** and unlawful transfer of people from the territory of Ukraine to the Russian Federation.

## US recognized McMahon Line as international border

- A bipartisan resolution was passed by the US, formally recognizing the McMahon Line as the international boundary between China and India's Arunachal Pradesh.
- The resolution rejected China's claim that the state belongs to its territory and instead acknowledged Arunachal Pradesh as an integral part of India.
- Furthermore, the resolution expressed support for India's sovereignty and territorial integrity.

## Bangladesh commissions its first submarine base

- Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina inaugurated the first submarine base of Bangladesh 'BNS Sheikh Hasina' at Pekua in Cox's Bazar.
- Hailing the newly inaugurated naval base as an 'ultra modern submarine base', Prime Minister called the event a proud chapter in the history of **Bangladesh navy.**
- This is the first ever full-fledged submarine base of Bangladesh Navy.
- Built at a cost of \$1.21 billion.
- The base can accommodate a total of six submarines and eight warships at a time.

## Japanese PM Kishida invites PM Modi to G7 Hiroshima summit

- Japanese Prime Minister **Fumio Kishida** has formally invited Prime Minister **NarendraModi** to the G7 Summit after both had a delegation-level talk at Delhi's Hyderabad House.
- PM Modi said that PM Kishida's visit will be helpful to maintain a momentum of mutual cooperation between India and Japan.
- He pointed out the importance of leading two significant summits, **G20 and G7**, by respective countries.

## Google Bard: Everything you should know about

- It is built on Transformer technology, which is also the backbone of ChatGPT and other AI bots.
- Transformer technology was pioneered by Google and made **open source in 2017.**
- Transformer technology is a **Neural Network Architecture**, which is **capable of making predictions based on inputs** and is primarily used in natural language processing and computer vision technology.

## Egypt joins BRICS bank as new member weeks after President Sisi's India visit

- After President **Abdel-Fattah El-Sisi** visited India as a chief guest for the Republic Day celebrations, **Egypt** has become a member of the BRICS New Development Bank (NDB).
- According to sources familiar with the matter, **Egypt** officially joined the NDB on February 20, with a formal notification issued on March 22.
- The African-Arab nation intends to enhance its infrastructure, and NDB funding can make a significant contribution toward achieving this goal.



## Jack Dorsey's wealth tumbles \$526 million after Hindenburg short

- Hindenburg Research's recent report accusing Block Inc. of ignoring extensive fraud has had a significant impact on co-founder Jack Dorsey's net worth.
- His fortune experienced its most substantial single-day decline since May, with a drop of 11%, resulting in a decrease of \$526 million.
- According to the Bloomberg Billionaires Index, Dorsey's net worth now stands at \$4.4 billion.



## Google Doodle celebrates 77th birth anniversary of late Kitty O'Neil

- Google Doodle: **Kitty O'Neil**, a famous American stuntwoman and actress who was deaf from a young age, was commemorated by Google on her **77th birthday anniversary** with a doodle featuring her in a yellow jumpsuit.
- She went on to become one of Hollywood's most famous stunt drivers.
- Google celebrated Kitty O'Neil's 77th birth anniversary with a doodle that depicted her in a yellow jumpsuit.
- Despite being deaf since childhood, she became a well-known stunt driver in Hollywood and held the women's absolute land speed record until 2019.

## First Citizens Bank Acquires Silicon Valley Bank

- First-Citizens Bank and Trust Company, based in Raleigh, North Carolina, has entered a purchase and assumption agreement with the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation (FDIC) to acquire all loans and deposits of the recently failed Silicon Valley Bridge Bank in the United States.
- The FDIC established Silicon Valley Bridge Bank, National Association after the California Department of Financial Protection and Innovation closed down Silicon Valley Bank.

## IPS officer RashmiShukla named Director-General of SSB

- Senior Indian Police Service (IPS) officer, **RashmiShukla** has been appointed as the **Director-General of the SashastraSeemaBal (SSB).** SSB is the borderguarding force deployed along Nepal and Bhutan border.
- RashmiShukla, a 1988 batch IPS officer of the Maharashtra cadre, was posted with the Central Reserve Police (CRPF).
- She was heading the State Intelligence Department in Maharashtra Police when the phones of Shiv Sena leader Sanjay Raut and Nationalist Congress Party leader EknathKhadse were allegedly tapped in 2019.

## IAF Participated in Exercise ShinyuuMaitri with Japan Air Self Defense Force

- The Indian Air Force (IAF) participated in Exercise ShinyuuMaitri with the Japan Air Self-Defence Force (JASDF).
- The Exercise ShinyuuMaitri is being organized on the sidelines of the Indo-Japan Joint Army Exercise, Dharma Guardian, which was conducted from 13 February 2023 to 02 March 2023 at Komatsu, Japan.
- The Indian Air Force is participating in **Exercise ShinyuuMaitri 23** with one C-17 Globemaster III aircraft.
- The Exercise has been conducted on the 1st and 2<sup>nd</sup> of March 2023. The first phase of the exercise consists of discussions on transport operations and tactical maneuvering, followed by the second phase of flying drills by **IAF's C-17 and JASDF C-2** transport aircraft.

## FRINJEX-23 Indo-France Joint Military Exercise to commence at Thiruvananthapuram

- On March 7 and 8, 2023, the **Indian Army** and the **French Army** will hold their first joint military exercise, **FRINJEX-23**, at **Pangode Military Station** in **Thiruvananthapuram**, Kerala.
- The two armies are participating in this format for the first time, with each contingent consisting of a Company Group from the French **6th Light Armoured Brigade** and Indian Army personnel stationed in **Thiruvananthapuram**.

#### Group Captain ShalizaDhami 1st woman to command frontline IAF combat unit

- In the first command appointment for a woman officer in the Indian Air Force (IAF), Group **Captain ShalizaDhami** has been selected to take over the command of a frontline combat unit in the Western sector.
- For the first time ever in the IAF's history, a woman officer has been given command of a frontline combat unit in this case, a missile squadron in the Western sector.
- The IAF's move comes just two months after Captain Shiva Chauhan of the Indian Army's Fire and Fury Corps became the

first woman officer to be operationally deployed at the world's highest battlefield in Siachen.







## In Ladakh, Colonel GeetaRana is the first woman to command an army battalion

- Colonel GeetaRana of the Corps of Electronics and Mechanical Engineers has taken over command of an independent field workshop in the Eastern Ladakh region with China after the Indian Army recently approved women officers for command posts.
- She is the first woman officer to do so. The Corps of Electronics and Mechanical Engineers' Colonel GeetaRana is the first female officer to assume control of an Independent Field Workshop in a remote and forward area in Eastern Ladakh.



## Indian Navy conducts major exercise TROPEX-23

- The Indian Navy's exercise, called the "Theatre Level Operational Readiness Exercise for 2023" (**TROPEX-23**), culminated in the **Arabian Sea** after running for four months from November 2022 to March 2023.
- TROPEX-23 witnessed the participation of approximately 70 Indian Navy ships, six submarines and over 75 aircraft.
- TROPEX is being is conducted in many phases to test Navy's transition from peacetime to hostilities.
- In the first phase, the Indian Navy had conducted coastal defence **exercise 'Sea Vigil'** along the entire coastline and Island territories of India on 12-13 January 2021.

## 54th CISF Raising Day observed on March 10 across the country

- Every year on March 10, the Central Industrial Security Force (CISF) Raising Day is observed to mark the CISF's founding in 1969.
- The Ministry of Home Affairs' top-tier central armed police force, the CISF, is in charge of providing security protection for several public sector organisations, airports, seaports, power plants, and other significant infrastructure projects across the nation.
- This year, the **54th CISF Raising Day** celebrated to appreciate the efforts and contributions of Central Industrial Security Force.

## Army installed J&K's steep Doda district's tallest iconic national flag

- In the rugged **Doda area of Jammu & Kashmir**, the Army erected the tallest "**Iconic National Banner**".
- The highest tricolour in the Doda district, which has been erected on a 100-foot pole, was unfurled by Maj Gen Ajay Kumar, GOC Delta Force, Commander 9 Sector RR Brig. Samir K. Palande, DC DodaVishesh Paul Mahajan, and SSP Abdul Qayoom.

## India, France conduct Maritime Partnership Exercise (MPX)

• Indian Navy's indigenously built guided missile frigate, INS Sahyadri participated in a Maritime Partnership Exercise (MPX) with French Navy (FN) ships FS Dixmude, a Mistral Class Amphibious Assault Ship and FS La Fayette, a La Fayette Class Frigate, in the Arabian Sea. The partnership exercise was conducted on March 10-11.

• According to the Ministry of Defence, the exercise witnessed a wide spectrum of evolutions at sea which included **cross-deck landings**, boarding exercises and seamanship evolutions.

## 3rd edition of Exercise La Perouse- 2023 begins

- On March 13 and 14, 2023, the Indian Ocean Area will host the third edition of the multilateral exercise La Perouse.
- The Royal Australian Navy, French Navy, Indian Navy, Japanese Maritime Self Defence Force, Royal Navy, and United States Navy will all have people, ships, and essential helicopters participating in this event.
- Every two years exercise La Perouse, an exercise run by the French Navy, aims to improve maritime domain awareness and maritime cooperation among the participating navies in the Indo-Pacific region.



## INS Dronacharya Receives Prestigious President DroupadiMurmu's Colour Award

- The Indian Navy's top gunnery school, **INS Dronacharya**, will be presented with the **President's Colour** in honor of its outstanding services.
- **President DroupadiMurmu** will be conferring the award as the highest recognition bestowed upon a unit by the President, who serves as the Supreme Commander of the armed forces, for its exceptional service to the country.

## Africa-India field training exercise AFINDEX-23 to be held in Pune

- The Africa-India Field Training Exercise (AFINDEX-2023) has begun with the participation of 100 participants from 23 African countries, including Botswana, Egypt, Ghana, Nigeria, Tanzania, and Zambia, among others.
- The exercise aims to improve interoperability and operational readiness for UN peacekeeping missions, and focuses on Humanitarian Mine Action and Peace Keeping Operations.
- The joint exercise is divided into four phases, including training of trainers, a Humanitarian Mine Action and Peace Keeping Operations Phase, and a validation exercise to assess the results of the training.
- The exercise seeks to enhance peace and security, exchange ideas, and promote a collaborative approach in capacity enhancement of African armies.
- Tactical drills, procedures, and the ability to operate jointly with seamless interoperability are the primary focus of the joint exercise.

## Annual Bilateral Maritime Exercise Konkan 2023

- The annual bilateral maritime exercise called **Konkan 2023** was conducted between the **Indian Navy and the Royal Navy** from 20th to 22nd March 2023 off the Konkan coast in the Arabian Sea.
- The Royal Navy is the United Kingdom's naval warfare force.
- The exercise involved **INS Trishul**, a guided missile frigate, and HMS Lancaster, a Type 23 guided missile frigate, and aimed to improve cooperation and learn best practices through various maritime drills.
- These drills covered air, surface, and sub-surface operations, such as gunnery shoots on an inflatable surface target called 'Killer Tomato,'





helicopter operations, anti-aircraft, and anti-submarine warfare exercises, Visit Board Search and Seizure (VBSS), ship manoeuvres, and personnel exchange.

• The maritime exercise proved to be highly beneficial for the personnel of both navies, as it displayed a remarkable level of professionalism and enthusiasm throughout its execution.

## GRSE launched the 'Most Silent Ship' INS Androth

- Garden Reach Shipbuilders and Engineers (GRSE), a shipbuilding company in India, has launched INS Androth, a vessel claimed to be the "most silent ship in the country" for the Indian Navy.
- The vessel is the first in a series of eight anti-submarine warfare shallow-watercraft to be delivered to the navy.
- The ships will be used for patrolling, search and rescue operations, and other military missions.
- The INS Androth has been designed to accommodate 50 crew members and is equipped with state-of-the-art communication systems, radars, and sonars to detect and track enemy submarines.

## First batch of Agniveers passes out of INS Chilka

- The "Agnipath" scheme is a defence recruitment initiative in India that aims to reduce the increasing salary and pension expenses by hiring short-term soldiers on a contract basis.
- These soldiers, known as 'Agniveer', will be initially recruited for four years, after which some of them may be retained.
- The scheme offers Indian youth an opportunity to serve in the Armed Forces and aims to achieve an optimal balance between youth and experience in the Army.
- Women will also be recruited into the armed forces under this scheme. Previously named "Tour of Duty", the initiative was launched in the presence of the Chiefs of the three Services.
- Currently, the Army recruits youth under Short Service Commission for an initial tenure of 10 years, which can be extended up to 14 years.

- Malhotra, a 1989 batch officer, had been working in Ministry of Finance since January 2018. "During the critical Covid-19

pandemic, he effectively steered the media and communication policy in the Ministry of Finance in sync with the various AatmaNirbhar Bharat Packages announced by the government over time to give relief to people and maintain economic balance,".

## Indo-American woman judge Tejal Mehta named first justice of a district court in US

- **Tejal Mehta**, an Indian-American woman judge who promised to make a real impact to the community and treat people with compassion, has taken oath as the first Justice of a district court in the US state of Massachusetts.
- Mehta will serve as the first Justice of the Ayer District Court. She has served as an Associate Justice with the same court and was unanimously selected and sworn in by Judge Stacey Fortes, Chief Justice of the District Court.

## S.S. Dubey takes charge as new Controller General of Accounts

- **S.S. Dubey** took charge as the new **Controller General of Accounts (CGA).** He is the 28th officer to hold the position of CGA.

## Xi Jinping starts third term as China's president


- Xi Jinping began an unprecedented third term as China's president after he was endorsed by a unanimous vote from the 2,977-member National People's Congress (NPC).
- Xi will head a hand-picked party and government team tasked with steering the world's second-largest economy through challenges at home and abroad over the next five years.
- After the voting, Xi took a constitutional oath, as both the **country**'s **president and head of its military** a symbolic move to show the significance of



the constitution after it was revised five years ago to scrap the presidential term limit, add Xi's political theory and emphasise the party's leadership of China.

#### Chief Minister of Nagaland and NDPP leader Neiphiu Rio takes the oath of office

- Neiphiu Rio, the leader of the Nationalist Democratic Progressive Party (NDPP), took the oath of office as the fifth Chief Minister of Nagaland. Governor La Ganesan gave the 72-year-old lawmaker the oath of secrecy.
- Mr. Rio is serving his fifth term and second consecutive term as the NDPP's leader. The deputy chief ministers of Nagaland, TadituiRangkauZeliang and Yanthungo Patton took the oath at Kohima among other Rio Cabinet members. Neiphiu Rio is contesting from home constituency Northern Angami-II.



#### Arun Subramanian becomes 1st Indian-American judge at New York Court

- Arun Subramanian, an attorney, has been appointed as the first Indian American judge of the Manhattan Federal District Court in New York.
- The nomination of Mr. Subramanian for the United States District Court for the Southern District of New York was first made public by US President Joe Biden in September 2022. The Senate confirmed the nomination of Subramanian by a vote of 58-37.

## Nepal elects Ram Chandra Paudel as its next president

- Ram Chandra Paudel has been elected to serve as the new president of Nepal.
- According to the Nepalese Election Commission, he received 33,800 electoral votes, while his opponent, Subash Chandra Nembwang, received 15,500 votes.
- Ram Chandra Paudel received votes from 352 members of provincial assemblies and 214 members of parliament.

## GoI appoints Siddhartha Mohanty as interim chairman of LIC

## JayantiChauhan to lead Bisleri after TCPL withdraws acquisition plan

- After Tata Consumer Products Ltd (TCPL) withdrew from acquiring Bisleri International, Ramesh Chauhan, the chairman of the company, announced that his daughter JayantiChauhan will now lead the bottled water company.
- He also stated that he has no intention of selling the business and is not currently in talks with any parties about doing so.
- JayantiChauhan is currently the vice chairperson of Bisleri and has been involved with the business for several years.
- She has been driving innovation and overseeing sales and marketing teams, with a focus on market penetration and brand value.
- TCPL confirmed that it has ceased negotiations with Bisleri and has not entered into any agreements for the acquisition.

## Former Brazilian President DilmaRousseff named new President of BRICS New Development Bank



- The New Development Bank (NDB), which is also known as the BRICS bank and is a
- multilateral financial institution created by Brazil, Russia, India, China, and South Africa, has announced that former **Brazilian President DilmaVanaRousseff** has been elected as its new President.
- She replaces **Marcus Troyjo** in the position. DilmaRousseff is an economist who served as the President of the Federative Republic of Brazil for two consecutive terms, from January 2011 to August 2016.



'Ironman' Krishna Prakash becomes first person to swim from Gateway of India to Elephanta Caves

- As part of the **'Drowning Prevention Awareness' campaign**, Indian Police Service (IPS) officer **Krishna Prakash** swam from Gateway of India to Elephanta Caves, Mumbai.
- He completed the expedition of 16.20 kms in just 5 hours 26 minutes and became the first person in history to do so.
- This is far from the first time the IPS officer broker broke records in sporting competitions. In 2017, he completed the Ironman Triathlon, one of the most challenging sports events in the world.



- This is a three-day event that requires the participants to complete a 3.8-kilometre swim, a 180.2-kilometer bicycle ride, and a 42.2 km run in 16–17 hours.
- This achievement earned Prakash the 'Iron Man' title and a mention in the World Book of Records.
- He was the first Indian Government Servant, Civil Servant, and Uniformed Services Officer, including Armed Forces and Paramilitary Forces, to earn this title!

## Indian-origin Sikh woman becomes Connecticut's first Asian assistant police chief

- Lt. Manmeet Colon, who is of Indian origin and a Sikh woman officer, has recently taken up the position of assistant police chief in the state of Connecticut, becoming the first-ever person of Asian descent to hold the position.
- She has been a member of the New Haven Police Department (NHPD) for 15 years and was appointed as the city's third assistant police chief in an official ceremony.



## Karnataka end 54-year wait, wins Santosh Trophy

- Karnataka ended their 54-year wait to win the Santosh Trophy national football championship, beating Meghalaya 3-2 in a pulsating final at the King Fahd International Stadium in the Saudi Arabia capital.
- Services beat Punjab 2-0 in the playoff to finish third. PP Shafeel and Christopher Kamei scored in either half. Services, winners of five of the last 10 editions, took the lead in the seventh minute through a strike from distance by Shafeel before Kamei converted a left-footed attempt from outside the box.



## Max Verstappen wins season-opening Bahrain Grand Prix 2023

Women's World Boxing Championships 2023: MC Mary Kom, FarhanAkhtar named brand ambassadors

- **The Indira Gandhi Sports Complex** in New Delhi will host the IBA Women's World Boxing Championship 2023 from March 15–26.

## FIFA president Gianni Infantino re-elected for another term

- Gianni Infantino was re-elected as FIFA president until 2027 by acclamation, after highlighting his strong financial performance as a reason for keeping a CEO in their position for life.
- The decision was made by the congress of 211 member federations, who have seen their annual funding from FIFA increase from \$250,000 to \$2 million since Infantino's first win in 2016.
- Following the 2022 World Cup in Qatar, FIFA now has \$4 billion in reserves, and it conservatively predicts a record



revenue of at least \$11 billion from the 2026 men's World Cup, which will be hosted in North America.

## Irani Cup 2022-23 final: Rest of India crowned champions

- In the final of the Irani Cup 2022/23, **Team Rest of India** secured their 30th title win in the Indian domestic tournament, continuing their dominant performance.
- They defeated **Madhya Pradesh** by 238 runs. YashasviJaiswal, who showcased brilliant batting skills across both innings, was adjudged the Player of the Match.
- He smashed a double century and a century in the two innings, contributing significantly to ROI's victory.



## Former Australia Cricket Captain Tim Paine Announces Retirement from the Sport

- **Tim Paine**, the former captain of the Australian test cricket team, has announced his retirement from cricket after playing his last **Sheffield Shield first-class match for Tasmania against Queensland.**
- Paine led the Australian team in 23 tests from 2018 to 2021 and played a total of 35 tests in his career.
- He took over as captain after Steve Smith was stripped of the role following the ball-tampering scandal during Australia's 2018 tour of South Africa.

## PankajAdvani retains Asian Billiards title defeating Damani

- PankajAdvani, the Indian cue sports champion, has retained his Asian Billiards title in the 100-up format after defeating his compatriot BrijeshDamani 5-1 in the final held at Qatar Billiards and Snooker Federation (QBSF) Academy.
- Advani, who has won the International Billiards and Snooker Federation (IBSF) world championship 25 times, won the match with a scoreline of 100(51)-18, 100(88)-9, 86(54)-101(75), 100-26, 100(66)-2, 101(64)-59.

## IPL India's first unicorn with a \$1.1 billion valuation: D&P report

- **D&P** Advisory has analyzed the Indian Premier League (IPL) and reported that the cricket tournament was India's first unicorn, with a valuation of \$1.1 billion in 2008, the year it was launched.
- The advisory had previously announced that IPL had become a decacorn (valued at \$10.9 billion) recently. D&P Advisory is now preparing to publish a new analysis called "IPL: The Pioneer of Indian Unicorns."

## Sergio Pérez wins Saudi Arabia Grand Prix 2023

- At its 205th meeting, the Executive Council of **UNESCO** declared March 14 to be the International Day of Mathematics.


World Consumer rights Day 2023 observed on March 15th globally
