AnjiKhad bridge, first cable stayed rail bridge in India

- India's Union Railway Minister, **AshwiniVaishnaw**, has shared a timelapse video showcasing the construction of the AnjiKhad Bridge, the country's first cable-stayed rail bridge.
- With a total of 96 cables spanning a length of 653km, the bridge is part of the challenging Udampur-Srinagar-Baramulla-Rail Link (USBRL) Project in the Reasi district of Jammu and Kashmir.



- Kpler data has revealed that India has become the largest supplier of refined fuels to Europe, surpassing Saudi Arabia. This comes as a result of Europe's reduced access to Russian oil and their growing dependence on Indian crude oil products.
- Europe is set to increase its refined fuel imports from India to over **360,000 barrels** a day, however this ultimately yields more demand for Moscow's crude, which carries freight costs.

- Over the course of 15 chapters, the book special also offers insights and perspectives from grassroots change-makers and iconic personalities.


Supreme Court allows divorce on the grounds of "irretrievable breakdown of marriage"


- The **Supreme Court of India** has granted couples the **right to divorce** on the grounds of "irretrievable breakdown of marriage" under **Article 142** of the Constitution.
- This ruling applies to cases where both parties seek a mutual consent divorce or where one partner seeks a divorce despite opposition from the other.

World Press Freedom Index 2023: India ranks 161 out of 180 countries

- According to the latest report from global media watchdog Reporters Without Borders (RSF), India has slipped to the 161st position out of 180 countries in the 2023 World Press Freedom Index.
- The report was released by RSF, and it indicates a decline in India's ranking for press freedom. Nordic countries like **Norway**, **Ireland, and Denmark** ranked top three respectively while **Vietnam**, **China**, **and North Korea** were the bottom three countries on the index.









India edges past China to send more students to US in 2022

- As per a report by **US Immigration and Customs Enforcement**, there has been a significant rise in the number of Indian students who have gone to the **United States in 2022**.
- India has emerged as the leader when it comes to international students in the US, surpassing China, as reported by the US annual report which states that **64,300 students** from India went to the US in 2022, whereas the number from China declined to 24,796.

• Retired Indian Administrative Service (IAS) officer Amitabh Kant, who served as Chief Executive Officer (CEO) of the National Institution for Transforming India (NITI Aayog) (2016-2022), has authored a new book titled "Made In India: 75 Years of Business and Enterprise" published by the Rupa Publications India.

National Manufacturing Innovation Survey: Karnataka ranked the most 'innovative' State

- A survey on the degree of innovation among manufacturing firms found that **Karnataka**, overall, is the most "innovative" State, followed by **Telangana, and Tamil Nadu**.
- The National Manufacturing Innovation Survey (NMIS) 2021-22, released earlier this month, also found that innovation in manufacturing is the lowest in the Northeastern states (excluding Assam), followed by Bihar.

- Ayodhya as a global tourism hotspot, the Uttar Pradesh government is planning to develop a theme park 'Ramaland' modelled on Disneyland to narrate the story of Lord Ram.

Foreign Ministers of SCO member countries meet in Goa

- India, the host country, attaches special importance to the SCO in promoting multilateral, political, security, economic, and people-to-people interactions in the region. India's theme for its Chairmanship of SCO in 2023 is 'SECURE-SCO'.

India leads as top source market for Sri Lanka's tourism for April 2023

- India led as the top source market for Sri Lanka's tourism sector for the month of April 2023. India regained the top spot after six months as almost 20,000 Indian tourists arrived in the island nation last month.
- Sri Lanka's Tourism Authority figures showed that 19,915 Indians had visited the island in April over 14,656 Russian tourist arrivals.



Russians remained the top inbound market from October 2022 to March this year. Tourist arrivals from India in 2022 stood at 1.23 lakhs with a share of 17.1 per cent. In April, the arrivals topped 100,000 for the fourth consecutive time since in the island taking the total arrivals in the first four months to over 4.4 lakhs.

New Lithium deposits discovered in Rajasthan after J-K

- Lithium reserves have been discovered in Rajasthan's Degana following the recent discovery in Jammu and Kashmir's Reasi.
- The newly discovered reserves in Degana are believed to be larger than those found in Jammu and Kashmir and officials claim that they could meet up to 80% of India's demand for lithium. This is the first time that lithium reserves have been found in Degana.



Mumbai-Ahmedabad High Speed Rail Corridor (MAHSR)

- The **Mumbai-Ahmedabad High-Speed Rail Corridor (MAHSR)** is currently under construction to link the major cities of Mumbai and Ahmedabad in India.
- Once completed, it will be the country's first high-speed rail line, resulting in a considerable reduction in travel time between the two cities from 6 hours 35 minutes to just 1 hour 58 minutes.

India operationalized Sittwe port in Myanmar

- **The Sittwe Port in Myanmar** has been put into operation by India, with the first shipment departing from the Syama Prasad Mookerjee Port in Kolkata.
- The project is a part of the Kaladan Multimodal Transit Transport initiative. The inaugural shipment, carrying 20,000 bags of cement weighing 1,000 metric tonnes, is expected to arrive at the Sittwe Port.



Santiniketan in tentative list for UNESCO World Heritage list

- The UNESCO World Heritage Centre has recommended Santiniketan, the cultural site in
- West Bengal, India, for inclusion in the **UNESCO World Heritage List**. The International Council on Monuments and Sites (ICOMOS), a France-based international nongovernmental organization, made the recommendation.
- The ICOMOS is an advisory body to the UNESCO World Heritage Centre, comprising experts, representatives from local authorities, heritage organizations, and companies. **Union Culture Minister G Kishan Reddy** has



expressed hope that the site would be formally inscribed on the World Heritage List in the World Heritage Committee meeting in Riyadh, Saudi Arabia, in September 2023.

MastercardTakes Over as ICC's Global Sponsor, Replacing BharatPe

- **Mastercard** has reportedly taken over from **BharatPe** as the global sponsor of the **International Cricket Council (ICC)**, a multinational financial services corporation based in the United States.
- Over the past year, **Mastercard** has been actively seeking to secure lucrative sponsorship deals and has already secured the title sponsorship rights for the **Board of Control for Cricket in India** (**BCCI**) international and domestic home fixtures from **Paytm**.

Supreme Court Rules Delhi Government has Control Over IAS and All Services in Delhi except Land, Police, and Law and Order

- In a significant judgment, the **Supreme Court** has granted control over all services in the national capital, including the Indian Administrative Service (IAS), to the **Delhi government**, except for those related to land, police, and law and order.
- The Constitution Bench comprising **Chief Justice of India DY Chandrachud** and Justices MR Shah, Krishna Murari, HimaKohli, and PS Narasimha passed a unanimous judgment on the matter.



AyushmannKhurrana Joins Indian Team as Ambassador for Special Olympics Journey to Berlin

- Bollywood star **AyushmannKhurrana** has been chosen to inspire and support the Indian contingent participating in the upcoming **Special Olympics for individuals with intellectual disabilities,** set to take place in Berlin from June 16 to June 25.
- Expressing gratitude, the actor considers himself lucky to have met numerous exceptional individuals throughout his journey.

Alia Bhatt appointed as first Indian Global Ambassador of Gucci


- Gucci, the luxury fashion brand from Italy, has appointed Alia Bhatt as its first global ambassador from India. She will debut as the brand's newest global ambassador at the Gucci Cruise 2024 show in Seoul next week.
- This appointment is an important moment for both the brand and the Indian fashion industry, especially since it comes after **Bhatt's Met Gala debut**.

DeepikaPadukone appears on cover of TIME magazine

- Bollywood star **DeepikaPadukone** has been featured on the latest cover of **TIME magazine**. The iconic American magazine described Padukone as a 'global star' bringing 'the world to Bollywood'. It had previously named Padukone among its list of 100 most influential people in the world in 2018.
- Deepika is called 'the most popular actress in the world's most populous country'. On the cover, she is seen wearing a beige oversized suit and no shoes.

Cyclone Mocha: All About The Storm

- **Cyclone Mocha** was a very severe cyclonic storm that formed in the Bay of Bengal on May 10, 2023. The storm intensified rapidly, reaching peak winds of 160 kilometers per hour (100 miles per hour) before making landfall in Bangladesh on May 14.
- The storm caused widespread damage in Bangladesh and Myanmar, killing at least 100 people and displacing millions more. Cyclone Mocha was named on the basis of a suggestion made by **Yemen.**



National Medical Commission makes unique ID mandatory for doctors

- **Doctors** will now have to get a Unique Identification Number (UID) to be able to practice medicine in the country, as per the new regulations by the National Medical Commission (NMC).
- The UID will be generated centrally by the NMC ethics board and thereby grant the practitioner, registration in NMR and eligibility to practice medicine in India. According to the new notification by NMC, there will be a common national medical register for all the registered medical practitioners of the country.



• The same will be maintained by the Ethics and Medical Registration Board (EMRB) under the NMC. This register will contain all the entries of the registered medical practitioners of all State Registers maintained by the various State Medical Councils and will have all relevant information regarding the medical practitioner.

Tungnath temple built by Pandavas declared national monument

- **Tungnath,** located in Rudraprayag, Uttarakhand, is not only one of the highest Shiva temples in the world but also the highest among the five PanchKedar temples.
- **Recently, it has been designated as a national monument.** The Central Government declared Tungnath a monument of national importance in a notification dated March 27. The Archaeological Survey of India (ASI), led by Devraj Singh Rautela, confirmed that they had been working towards this recognition for a significant period.



During the process, ASI actively sought public opinions and objections regarding the

declaration of Tungnath as a national heritage.

6th Indian Ocean Conference- IOC 2023

- The Indian Ocean Conference (IOC) was established in 2016 and over the past six years, it has become the prominent consultative forum for nations in the region to discuss regional affairs. The objective of the IOC is to facilitate discussions on regional cooperation for Security And Growth for All in the Region (SAGAR) by bringing together important states and principal maritime partners of the region on a common platform.
- The 6th IOC is set to take place on May 12-13, 2023, in Dhaka, Bangladesh, and is being organised by India Foundation in association with the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Government of Bangladesh, and **S. Rajaratnam** School of International Studies in Singapore. The theme for the conference is **"Peace, Prosperity and Partnership for a Resilient Future"**. The conference aims to bring together a distinguished gathering of key stakeholders to chart the course for strengthening the Indian Ocean Region.

'Supreme Court On Commercial Arbitration' book By Dr. Manoj Kumar Released

• A compendium of three volumes with Judgments spanning from the year 1988 till 2022 covering Arbitration Act 1940 and 1996, the book titled 'Supreme Court on Commercial

Arbitration' by Dr.Manoj Kumar and fore worded by Shri.R.Venkataramani was released on 13.05.2023 being the founders day of Hammurabi & Solomon Partners.

There has been substantial jurisprudence laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the Country on Commercial Arbitration spanning over multiple statutory frameworks.

India observes National Dengue Day on May 16 every year

- National Dengue Day is observed on May 16 every year to raise awareness about the mosquito-borne disease. Dengue cases usually surge in India during and after the monsoon season.
- The Union Ministry of Health and Family Welfare organises different events to observe National Dengue Day at several levels across the country. Dengue is caused by four distinct viruses and is spread by the female Aedes mosquitoes, which also transmit yellow fever, Zika viruses, and chikungunya.
- The recent information from a Lancet study indicates that between January and October of last year, approximately 1,10,473 cases of dengue were reported in India. As a result, it's critical to be aware of the disease's necessary preventative measures.


India & Bangladesh launch '50 Start-ups Exchange Programme'

- The initial batch of 10 start-up companies participating in the 50 start-ups exchange program between India and Bangladesh have returned to Dhaka after a successful visit to India from May 8-12. These start-ups operate in various sectors, including e-commerce, health, transport and logistics, energy, education, and skill development.
- The exchange program facilitates visits between 50 start-ups from Bangladesh and 50 start-ups from India, aiming to foster partnerships, expand business relations, share experiences and knowledge, and promote collaboration among young entrepreneurs.
- The framework of this program was established during recent bilateral summits between the Prime Ministers of both countries.

India plans to challenge EU carbon tax at WTO

- According to government and industry sources, India is planning to lodge a complaint with the World Trade Organisation about the European Union's proposal to levy tariffs ranging from 20% to 35% on high-carbon goods like steel, iron ore, and cement from India.
- This move comes as part of New Delhi's effort to resist the EU's Carbon Border Adjustment Mechanism (CBAM), a measure intended to incentivize local industries to adopt cleaner technologies to reduce carbon emissions, while also being discussed in bilateral talks.

Govt shuffles cabinet: KirenRijiju exited as Union Law Minister







- **KirenRijiju** has exited as Union Law Minister and will now take up the portfolio of **Ministry of Earth Sciences. Arjun Ram Meghwal** has been assigned the independent charge as Minister of State in the Ministry of Law and Justice in addition to his existing portfolios.
- Rijiju took over as the Law and Justice Minister on July 8, 2021. Prior to this, he served as the Minister of State (Independent Charge) of Youth Affairs and Sports from May 2019 to July 2021. Union Minister Jitendra Singh was holding charge of the Ministry of Earth Sciences.

METRO sells India Cash & Carry to Reliance Retail for Rs 2,850cr

- The German retailer, **METRO AG**, has announced the full completion of the sale of its Indian cash and Carry business to **Reliance Retail Ventures Ltd** (**RRVL**), which operates the retail empire of Reliance Industries Ltd.
- As part of the deal, **RRVL** has acquired all 31 wholesale stores that were operated by **METRO Cash & Carry India** and the entire real estate portfolio, which includes six store-occupied properties.
- The deal, which was announced in December 2022, is reportedly worth ₹2,850 crore and will help Reliance Retail strengthen its dominant position in India's massive retail sector, which is one of the fastest-growing markets globally.

TN CM Stalin Inaugurates one of India's Biggest Skywalk Bridge

The recently inaugurated one of India's biggest Skywalk bridges, spanning 570 meters in

length and 4.2 meters in width, was officially opened by Tamil Nadu Chief Minister **MK Stalin.** This skywalk bridge serves as a crucial connection between the Mambalam railway station and T Nagar bus terminus. The project is part of a larger multi-modal initiative aimed at facilitating pedestrian movement.

- The move comes as the objective of introducing the ₹2000 banknotes has been fulfilled, and other denominations now adequately meet the currency requirements of the economy.

- According to **Mr. Shah**, this sceptre holds historical significance as it was originally presented to India's first Prime Minister, Jawaharlal Nehru, symbolizing the transfer of power from the **British** to the Indian people.
- The Home Minister explained that the sceptre, known as "sengol," derives from the Tamil word "semmai," meaning "righteousness."

Kerala Becomes India's First Fully E-Governed State, Achieving Total E-Governance

- Kerala, the southern state of India, is set to make history by declaring itself as the country's first "total e-governed state."
- Building upon its reputation as the first fully-literate state in **India**, Kerala has achieved this milestone through a series of policy initiatives aimed at transforming the state into a digitallyempowered society.
- With a focus on a knowledge-based economy and 100% digital literacy, the government has digitized the delivery of vital

services across various domains, ensuring transparency, inclusivity, and accessibility for all citizens.

Microsoft launches Jugalbandi, a multilingual AI-chat bot for rural India

- Microsoft has launched Jugalbandi, a generative AI-driven multilingual chatbot accessible
- via popular messaging platform, WhatsApp. The bot has been especially made to cover areas of rural India which aren't easily penetrated through media and lack access to government's welfare activities.
- The chatbot has been developed by AI4Bharat in collaboration with IIT Madras. It is aimed at providing personalised assistance by understanding user queries in multiple languages, whether spoken or typed. The



chatbot was launched in April and has been tested in **Biwan**, a village near India's capital city of New Delhi.

Centre to Launch New ₹75 Coin to Mark New Parliament Inauguration

- The Ministry of Finance has announced the launch of a special ₹75 coin to commemorate the inauguration of India's new parliament building.
- Prime Minister **NarendraModi** will unveil the coin on Sunday, 28 May, coinciding with the celebration of India's 75 years of independence.

NTCA Constitutes New Committee to Oversee Cheetah Project

- National Tiger Conservation Authority (NTCA) has established an 11-member Cheetah Project Steering Committee under the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change, and Rajesh Gopal, secretary general of Global Tiger Forum, has been appointed as its chairman.
- The decision was taken after six cheetahs, who were brought as part of the translocation project, died in the last two months.
- The other 10 members include RN Mehrotra, former principal chief conservator of forest of Rajasthan; PR Sinha, former director of the Wildlife Institute of India; HS Negi, former APCCF, Wildlife; and PK Malik, former faculty at WII.

PM Modi Chairs 8th Governing Council Meeting of NitiAayog, Emphasizes Team India Approach for a Developed Nation by 2047

- Prime Minister Shri **NarendraModi** recently presided over the **8th Governing Council** Meeting of NitiAayog, held at the New Convention Centre in New Delhi. The meeting saw the participation of Chief Ministers and Lieutenant Governors representing 19 states and 6 union territories.
- In his address, Prime Minister Modi underscored the importance of collaborative efforts between the central government, states, and union territories to realize the aspirations of the people and transform India into a developed nation by 2047.

Revised Guidelines for SPG: Special Force Safeguarding PM to be Led by ADG

- The security responsibility of the prime minister, currently undertaken by the **Special Protection Group (SPG)**, will now be overseen by an officer of the **Indian Police Service** holding the rank of at least an **additional director general (ADG)**.
- Junior officers will be appointed on deputation for an initial period of six years. The **Ministry of Home Affairs** recently issued new rules, outlined in a gazette notification under the **Special Protection Group Act** of **1988** (**34 of 1988**), establishing these criteria.
- As per the notification, officers from the **All India Services** will be selected for deputation to the SPG by




the central government, under the same terms and conditions applicable to officers of corresponding ranks in the central government.



Goa Statehood Day 2023 observed on 30th May

- The smallest state by area, Goa is famous for its beaches and the relics of its colonial past. It got its statehood on May 30, 1987. It was a Portuguese territory since Alfonso de Albuquerque conquered it in 1510 by defeating Adil Shah of Bijapur who was ruling the region.
- 400 years later, India took back Goa from the Portuguese. This year Goa celebrates its **36th anniversary** of statehood.

AI 'godfather' Geoffrey Hinton quits Google



Indo-Canadian RupiKaur book among most banned in US schools

- **RupiKaur,** a Canadian-Sikh poet, has made it to the list of 11 most banned books in US classrooms for the first half of the 2022-23 school year.
- Kaur's debut work, 'Milk and Honey', which was released in 2014, has been banned due to its exploration of issues related to sexual assault and violence, according to non-profit organisation PEN America, which provided the data. Last month, Kaur's Twitter account was also withheld in India due to the Khalistan issue.



JPMorgan Acquires First Republic Bank Amidst Recent Failures of Major US Banks

- American regulators announced that First Republic Bank had been taken over and that an agreement had been reached to sell the bank to JPMorgan Chase & Co. This marks the third major U.S. financial institution to fail in just two months.
- JPMorgan is set to acquire \$173 billion in loans and around \$30 billion in securities, which includes \$92 billion in deposits from First Republic Bank, but they are not taking on the bank's corporate debt or preferred stock.



Bastille Day celebration in Paris, PM Modi accepts French invite for the celebration

- The Ministry of External Affairs announced that French President **Emmanuel Macron** had extended an invitation to Prime Minister **NarendraModi** to be the Guest of Honour at the Bastille Day Parade in Paris on July 14, and that Mr.Modi had accepted.
- According to an official press release, a contingent from the Indian armed forces will also take part in the parade, which celebrates "liberty, equality and fraternity."



Russia stages the 78th Victory Day parade at Red Square, Moscow

- Russia held the **78th Victory Day parade** anniversary on May 9th, at Red Square in Moscow to celebrate the historic victory of the **Soviet Union in 1945**, when they defeated Nazi Germany in World War II, also known as the Great Patriotic War.
- This year's parade featured more than 10,000 individuals and 125 pieces of weaponry, which were all showcased by the **Russian Defense Minister, Sergey Shoigu.**

42nd ASEAN Summit begins in Indonesia with focus on becoming global growth center

- The 42nd Summit of the Association of Southeast Asian Nations (ASEAN) has kicked off in Indonesia with a theme of "ASEAN Affairs: Epicenter of Growth."
- The summit aims to demonstrate the bloc's hopes and efforts to become the center and driving force behind global development. **President JokoWidodo**, who holds the presidency of the bloc, emphasized the enormous potential of the ASEAN region, which has a total population of around 650 million inhabitants and consistently outperforms the world average in terms of



economic growth. He called on member countries to unite in terms of production power to make Southeast Asia the center of global growth.

Pakistan's economic crisis: Hajj quota given up to Saudi Arabia

- For the first time in 75 years, **Pakistan** has made the decision to surrender its **Hajj quota** to **Saudi Arabia**. This move was prompted by the rising inflation in the country, which has caused thousands of Pakistanis to forgo the pilgrimage this year.
- In total, **Pakistan** has returned 8,000 unused seats, which will save the government a considerable amount of money totalling \$24 million.

Sri Lanka Supreme Court clears way to decriminalise homosexuality

- The **Supreme Court** of **Sri Lanka** has approved decriminalize **homosexuality**, according to the Speaker of Parliament, in a move welcomed by **LGBTQ**+ rights campaigners.
- Under current laws, **homosexuality** is punishable by imprisonment and fines, but activists have long campaigned for change. After hearing submissions from both sides, the **Supreme Court** ruled that the proposed legislation was not unconstitutional.

India among seven countries to benefit from Saudi Arabia's new e-visa system

- **Saudi Arabia** has introduced a new e-visa system to replace traditional visa stickers on passports.
- The initiative, which began in May 2023, is aimed at digitizing consular services and creating a new way to issue work, residency, and visit visas in seven countries: Jordan, United Arab Emirates (UAE), Egypt, India, Bangladesh, the Philippines, and Indonesia. The move comes as part of efforts to automate consular services and "develop a mechanism for granting different kinds of visas".



Google's Bard chatbot to launch globally, including India

- **Google** has announced that it will be rolling out its generative AI chatbot Bard in over **180 countries**, including India.
- Bard is a large language model (LLM) that can generate text, translate languages, write different kinds of creative content, and answer your questions in an informative way. In 2022, Google announced that Bard would be available in the United States and the United Kingdom. It is likely that the company will continue to roll out Bard to other English-speaking countries first.

WHO declares an end to global health emergency for mpox

- Google Bard
- The World Health Organization (WHO) announced on May 11 that the global health emergency for mpox, a viral disease formerly known as monkeypox, has ended after 10 months. This came after confirmed cases in over 100 countries since the disease started spreading globally in May 2022.
- The emergency committee of the WHO made the recommendation to end the health emergency, and WHO director-general **TedrosAdhanomGhebreyesus** announced the decision during a press conference.

Sherpa becomes 2nd person to scale Everest 26 times

- **PasangDawa Sherpa**, also known as **Pa Dawa**, successfully reached the summit of **Mount Everest** for the 26th time, equaling the record set by another Nepalese guide. Accompanied by a Hungarian climber, the 46-year-old achieved this feat.
- According to the Himalayan Database, which documents mountaineering achievements in Nepal's Himalayas, Pa Dawa had previously climbed Everest 25 times, including two ascents in 2022. Since his initial successful climb in 1998, Dawa has consistently made the journey nearly every year.

Brazil, top chicken exporter, confirms first ever avian flu cases in wild birds

- **Brazil**, known as the world's leading chicken exporter, has recently confirmed cases of **Highly Pathogenic Avian Influenza (HPAI)** in wild birds.
- Although these cases mark the first-ever occurrence in the country, the Brazilian government emphasizes that the situation will not lead to a ban on the importation of **Brazilian poultry products**, in accordance with guidelines from the World Organization for Animal Health (WOAH).
- While the avian influenza virus poses a threat to bird populations and the farming sector, the impact on Brazil's poultry industry remains limited.

PM Modi to visit Japan, Papua New Guinea, and Australia for G7 and Quad Summits

- Prime Minister NarendraModi will go on a three-nation tour, starting on May 19th and concluding on May 24th, which includes the G-7 Summit in Japan and the Quad Leaders' Summit in Australia.
- From the 19th to the 21st of May, the Prime Minister will visit **Hiroshima**, **Japan**, for the G-7 Summit under the Japanese Presidency, accepting an invitation from the Japanese Prime Minister **Fumio Kishida**.

The opening film for the festival is set to be Jeanne du Barry, directed by Maïwenn, while the festival will conclude with the popular Pixar motion picture Elemental, helmed by Peter Sohn.

Nepali Climber Makes Record, Climbs Mount Everest For 27th Time

- Nepali climber **Kami Rita Sherpa** reached the top of **Mount Everest** for the 27th time, reclaiming the record for the most summits of the world's highest mountain.
- The 53-year-old had held the title since 2018, when he ascended Everest for the 22nd time, passing the previous mark he shared with two other Sherpa climbers, both of whom have since retired.

Dr. L Murugan inaugurates India Pavilion at Marché du Film at 76th Cannes International Film Festival

- The India Pavilion was inaugurated by Union Minister of State for Information and Broadcasting, Dr. L Murugan, at the 76th Cannes International Film Festival in France.
- The pavilion showcases India's rich culture, heritage, and its thriving creative economy to the global audience.
- The event witnessed the presence of Indian Ambassador to France, Jawed Ashraf, Joint Secretary in the Ministry of Information and Broadcasting, Prithul Kumar, and prominent figures from the Indian film industry.

5,000-year-old 'Great Grandfather' tress is officially the world's oldest

- A **5,000-year-old tree in Chile** has been officially recognized as the world's oldest. The tree, a Patagonian cypress, is located in the AlerceCostero National Park and is nicknamed "Great Grandfather."
- It is estimated to be between 5,000 and 6,500 years old, making it the oldest living organism on Earth. The Great Grandfather tree is a massive specimen, measuring **28 meters tall and 4 meters (13 Feet) in diameter.**
- It is believed to have survived several major climate changes over the centuries, including the Little Ice Age. The tree is also a popular tourist destination, with thousands of visitors coming to see it each year.

Ruskin Bond wrote a new book titled 'The Golden Years'

- In contrast, Japan exported 954,185 vehicles, an increase of 6% from the previous year.

SpaceX Sends First Saudi Arabian Astronauts to the International Space Station



- In a groundbreaking moment for **Saudi Arabia**, the country's first astronauts in decades have embarked on a journey to the **International Space Station (ISS)**.
- Sponsored by the Saudi Arabian government, a female stem cell researcher named **RayyanahBarnawi** and a Royal Saudi Air Force fighter pilot named Ali al-Qarni joined a crew led by a retired NASA astronaut from Kennedy Space Center.
- The mission was organized by Axiom Space, a Houston-based company, and executed by SpaceX.

'World Health Assembly' PM Modi addresses 76th Session in Geneva, Switzerland

- The Prime Minister of India, **ShriNarendraMod**i, addressed the 76th Session of the **World Health Assembly** in Geneva, Switzerland.



- She was promoted to the rank of Captain last month. Maldonado, 45, was born in Punjab, India, and moved to the United States with her family when she was 9 years old. She joined the NYPD in 1999 and has served in a variety of roles, including patrol officer, detective, and sergeant.

Siddaramaiah to be the next chief minister in Karnataka CM Race

- According to reports, **Siddaramaiah** is set to become the next chief minister of Karnataka, with **DK Shivakumar** as his deputy.
- The decision was reached by the **Congress party**, with both leaders agreeing to a rotational arrangement.
- **Siddaramaiah** will serve as the chief minister for a period of 2.5 years, after which Shivakumar will take over the position.

KV Viswanathan, PrashantMishratotake oath as Supreme Court judges


- Lionel Messi, who led Argentina to victory in the 2022 World Cup as their captain, was • honored with the Laureus Sportsman of the Year award at a


FC Barcelona lifts 27th La Liga Title, First La Liga since 2019

Mahatma Gandhi's grandson Arun Gandhi passes away at 89

- Former 100m world champion sprinter from the United States of America, **Tori Bowie**, died at the age of 32. The American was crowned world champion in 2017 and won three Olympic medals at the Rio Games in 2016.
- She won the Olympic Gold with the USA relay team at the Rio Olympics in 2016. Tori was born and brought in Mississippi where she played basketball as a child before taking up track events.



Mexico football legend Antonio Carbajal passes away at 93

- Antonio Carbajal, the first Mexican player to appear in five World Cups, has passed away at the age of 93.
- Carbajal, who was nicknamed "La Tota," played for Mexico between 1950 and 1966, making 11 World Cup appearances. He was a key member of the Mexico team that reached the quarterfinals of the 1958 World Cup.
- He is best known for his record-setting five appearances at the FIFA World Cup, a feat replicated by only two other men since (as of 2018): Germany's LotharMatthäus in 1998 and Rafael Márquez of Mexico in 2018.

Hinduja Group chairman SP Hinduja passes away at 87

• SrichandParmanandHinduja, the eldest of the four Hinduja brothers and chairman of Hinduja Group, died in London. He was unwell for some time. He was 87. They grew their family business, which includes commercial vehicle maker Ashok Leyland and private bank IndusInd, to several businesses across 38 countries, in sectors such as oil lubricants, chemicals, energy and IT.



• The group employs more than 200,000 people. A guide for more than two decades, Kami Rita Sherpa first summited the 8,848-metre (29,029-foot) peak in 1994 when working for a commercial expedition. Since then, he has climbed Everest almost every year, several times leading the first rope-fixing team to open the route to the world's highest point.

Legendary Singer Tina Turner 'Queen of Rock' Dies Aged 83

- **Tina Turner**, the '**Queen of Rock'n'Roll**' has passed away at the age of 83 after a long illness in her home in Kusnacht near Zurich, Switzerland.
- The singer, Tina Turner, rose to prominence after performing with her husband Ike Turner in the 1960s before overcoming his violent, abusive behavior to go on to become a chart-topping solo artist.
- Turner earned fans all over the world for her riveting live performances, and was best known for songs such as "Private Dancer", "The Best", "What's Love Got to Do With It" and "Proud Mary". Turner was diagnosed with intestinal cancer in 2016 and received a kidney transplant in 2017.

- This year's World Press Freedom Day focuses on the theme of **"Shaping a Future of Rights: Freedom of Expression**


as a Driver for All Other Human Rights," which emphasizes the critical role of freedom of expression in safeguarding and promoting other human rights.


International Nurses Day 2023 Observed on 12th May


International Museum Day 2023 Observed on 18th May
