# Government Plans to Sell up to 3% Stake in Coal India

• The Indian government has announced its intention to sell up to a 3% stake in **Coal India** Ltd through the offer for sale (OFS) route, according to a recent regulatory filing.

• The OFS will be open for both retail and non-retail investors on June 1 and 2, offering an opportunity to participate in the sale of shares in the renowned coal producer.

# India's GDP Growth Accelerates to 6.1% in Q4 2022-23, Propelling Economy to \$3.3 Trillion

- **India's economy** showcased significant growth in the January-March quarter of 2022-23, with a GDP growth rate of 6.1%.


### What is Railway kavach system?


A significant step towards improving train operation safety in India has been taken by Ministry
of Railways with the development of Kavach, an indigenous Automatic Train Protection
System.

- The Research Designs and Standards Organisation (RDSO) collaborated with three Indian vendors to create Kavach, which assists locomotive pilots in avoiding Signal Passing At Danger (SPAD) and over speeding, while also aiding train operation during adverse weather conditions such as dense fog.
- By automatically applying brakes when necessary, Kavach ensures better control of train speed and prevents potential accidents.

# Ahmednagar Renamed Ahilyadevi Nagar: A Move to Empower the Dhangar Community

- The Maharashtra government has recently announced the renaming of Ahmednagar district to Ahilyadevi Nagar in honor of the 18th-century warrior-queen AhilyadeviHolkar.
- This decision is seen as a significant step to appease and empower the Dhangar community, which holds considerable numerical strength in Maharashtra's population.





- The Indian government has established a commission of inquiry, led by former Chief Justice of the Gauhati High Court, AjaiLamba, to investigate the recent

- This groundbreaking achievement highlights India's innovation and expertise in the aviation sector.



#### Karnataka announces free bus travel 'Shakti' scheme for women


- The Karnataka government has advised the women to apply for Shakti smart cards to avail the free travel in state run buses, starting from June 11.

## India's overall exports in May 2023 stands at US\$ 60.29 Billion






# UNESCO: U.S. to Rejoin in July








## Indonesia Open 2023: Satwiksairaj& Chirag as men's doubles champions


### RajyaSabha MP Hardwar Dubey passes away


• The BharatiyaJanata Party (BJP) senior leader and RajyaSabha member from Uttar


